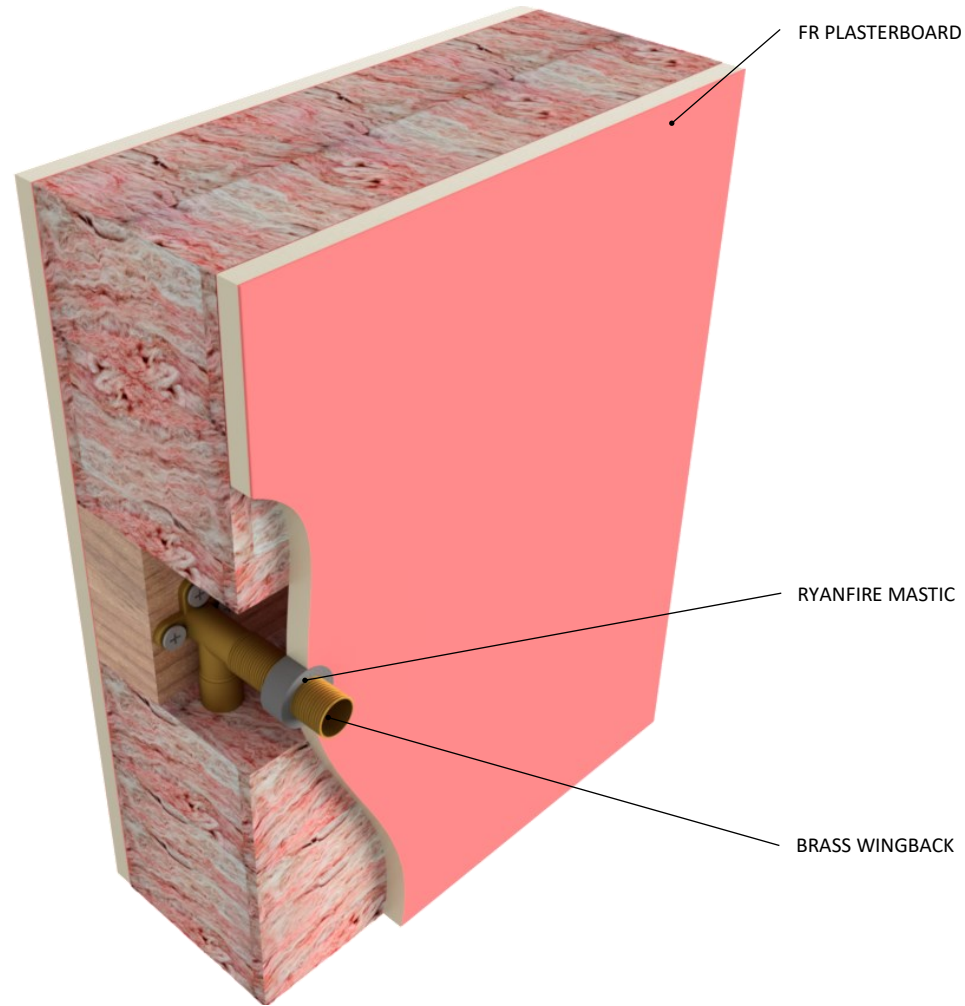


INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. ENSURE THE APERTURE IS CLEAN AND FREE OF DUST AND DEBRIS.
2. APPLY RYANFIRE MASTIC INTO THE ANNULAR GAP BETWEEN THE BRASS WINGBACK AND THE PLASTERBOARD WALL TO THE FULL DEPTH OF THE PLASTERBOARD.
3. REMOVE ANY EXCESS RYANFIRE MASTIC WITH A DAMP CLOTH.
