
INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- ENSURE THE APERTURE IS CLEAN AND FREE OF DUST AND DEBRIS.
- 2. APPLY 10MM DEEP TRAFALGAR FYREFLEX INTO THE ANNULAR GAP BETWEEN THE PIPE AND THE WALL.
- 3. PLACE ONE HALF OF THE BLADERUNNER (WITH THE STICKER VISIBLE) AROUND THE PIPE AND UP AGAINST THE WALL.
- 4. SECURE THE BLADERUNNER IN PLACE WITH TWO M6 X 50MM CONCRETE ANCHORS, USING THE PRE-FORMED FIXING HOLES. DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN THE ANCHORS.
- 5. INSTALL THE SECOND HALF OF THE BLADERUNNER IN THE SAME WAY AS THE FIRST HALF.
- 6. REPEAT THIS PROCESS ON THE OPPOSITE SIDE OF THE WALL.

NOTE: THE CABLE TIES FORM PART OF THE PRODUCT MECHANISM.

DO NOT CUT THE CABLE TIES
