# NZS4541:2020 and Seismic Provisions

Designers and contractors need to be aware of a number of issues with respect to the new seismic design provisions included in NZS4541:2020.

## Design Loads

There is an area of ambiguity in the clauses, where the standard calls up Parts Category P4 in one clause, but lists Parts Category 5 & 6 in a Table. This is currently being reviewed, as the committee has been alerted by a number of seismic specialists that they consider this is an error. Unfortunately, there are a number of diverging view points as to whether the correct Parts Category is 3, 4 or 5. One thing that seems certain is that the reference to parts Category 6 is an error.

This will be resolved before the standard is cited. If NZS4541:2020 is being specified under the provisions of NZS4541:2013 clause 117, then Parts Category 4 should be used. If NZS4541:2020 is being specified as an alternative solution, then the designer will need to apply their own judgement and present this to the Sprinkler System Certifier for approval.

# Fire Fighting Chemicals Group Standard Updated

On 14 December 2020, after a lengthy review process that first began in September 2019, the Environmental Protection Authority (EPA) published an amendment to the Fire Fighting Chemicals Group Standard 2017 (HSR002573). Whilst this document covers all fire fighting chemicals, the changes were initiated to allow the risks associated with firefighting foams containing PFAS (perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances) to be better managed.

The FPA provided a submission to help ensure that the EPA had sufficient information for an informed decision to be made that met the challenges of preserving the safety of the public, the built environment and the natural environment from the direct and indirect impacts of fire and firefighting. Our preliminary review of the Group Standard amendment suggests that a reasonable balance has been struck.

Of note, the Group Standard now separates fire fighting foams based on their chemistry and has applied specific conditions to each:

- » **Legacy PFAS fire fighting foam** means a firefighting foam that contains PFOA-related compounds.
  - I.e. this has typically been referred to as C8-AFFF
  - Can only be used in contained fire fighting systems until 3 December 2025
  - Can only be used in uncontained fire fighting systems until 31 December 2022
  - No provision to extend the transitional period
- » **C6 fluorotelomer fire fighting foam** means a fire fighting foam predominantly made up of fluorinated organic compounds with a perfluorinated 6-carbon chain length or shorter.
  - I.e. this is typically referred to as C6-AFFF
  - Can only be used in contained or uncontained fire fighting systems until 3 December 2025
  - Provision for an extension past this date under section 95A of HSNO
- » **PFAS free fire fighting foam** means a fire fighting foam that does not contain PFAS.
  - I.e. this is a fluorine-free foam or F3.

In addition, there are also specific requirements around the need to contain all fire fighting foams to prevent their release to the environment. This affects not only testing and training activities, but must also be considered in relation to the false activation of fixed systems.

A complete write up of the Group Standard, and how the changes will likely affect the fire protection community, will be provided early in 2021. In the meantime, the Group Standard and decision document (explanatory information from the Decision Making Committee) can be accessed on the EPA website:

# HOFFE SIG Update

Well we are into the final stretch of 2020 which by any measure has been a crazy year! We have all had to adapt to situations we simply haven't had to face before. While internationally the COVID-19 situation is quite dire in places, at least our "new normal" isn't as restrictive. That said, the trickle-down effect has hit many of us in as much as getting products and components from overseas has become a major problem – this would include most HOFFE group member companies.

Despite the COVID restrictions which have resulted in a decrease in the number of HOFFE group meetings held this year, our group have had some success stories for the year. The most significant one I believe is that we have started the process for the NZS4503 review - in the HOFFE world I believe this is our foundation document. It influences so many aspects of our industry, whether you have an enquiry that relates to the selection, servicing or documentation of Fire Extinguishers, fire hose reels, fire blankets, wheeled mobile units or even "For Use" blazon signage, it is covered in the standard. As was discussed during our group meeting on November 25th we are presently compiling the relevant application information and getting our submission sorted. This is of course on top of nailing down our initial funding model which is coming together thanks to the co-operation and input from the FPANZ, the Fire Protection Trust and HOFFE group members.

While it was great to hear that another successful prosecution was made against Aero Fire earlier this year and that they also signed court enforceable undertakings not to sell or service fire equipment in New Zealand, we have however continued to hear accounts of Aero Fire re-emerging and trading under other company names. The FPA's message remains to please forward us the detailed accounts of any incidents involving them trading so we can pass these details on to the Commerce Commission or you can go directly to the Commerce Commission with the information yourselves. Please ensure that you have gathered sufficient information/detail and contact numbers so that the Commerce Commissions staff can investigate the incidents.

We also continue to hear of fire extinguishers that have apparently been allowed into the country but may not meet our criteria, that is to say may not have been import cleared or may not have been manufactured to an accepted standard. If you come across such a fire extinguisher please get as many details as you can particularly around how it came to be here and let the FPA know as we hear they are appearing in ever increasing numbers but we need proof and facts so that we can relay to the appropriate authorities??

Our next meeting is scheduled for the 12th February 10am (all things going well), have a great holiday break, enjoy your Christmas and New Year celebrations, stay safe and we hope to see you at a meeting next year either in person or via a video link.

Of particular interest and praise from them was the Level 3 Passive Installers Qualification along with the Diploma in Fire Engineering that is available to candidates entering the Fire Safety industry. Also they found great value in sections of our Intumescent Coatings Code of Practice

Great to hear the feedback from across the globe and praise for the work the group has done in recent years.

## NOVEMBER 20 BUILDING CODE UPDATE – FIRE

On 5 November 2020, updated Building Code documents were published. This included the fire related documents C/AS1, C/AS2 and C/VM2.

Cladding requirements were amended in C/VM2 and C/AS2 due to valuable feedback provided by the sector on proposed changes to these requirements, which we took on board. This resulted in the cladding guidance document been revised and re-released:

Amendments to C/VM2 also included changes to the requirements in the Design Scenario HS on horizontal fire spread. Heat flux values were added providing more clarity, and dispensation for sprinklers was added.



Changes to C/AS1 and C/AS2 give more clarity on whether a building fits within the scope of one or the other Acceptable Solution. It is now clear that for stacked household units to fall within the scope of C/AS1, there must be independent means of escape for each unit and the escape height may not exceed 4.0m.

Some terminology, such as 'dead end', and the start of a new open path had some contradictions within the definitions and the text. Other changes include the requirement for panic fastenings to be latching, not locking and that vision panels may be excluded for single person sanitary facilities or closets.

Amendments to group sleeping areas include that partitions are allowed in a risk group SM group sleeping area, beds are not fully enclosed. Further changes were made to align definitions with paragraphs, such as suites, household units and direct support functions.

In Part 5, amendments were made to Tables 5.2 and 5.3. Altogether, ten tables have been merged into six. This provides a more consistent approach to formatting and terminology with the rest of the document. Risk groups SM and SI are in one table as the requirements are similar, with a single value for risk group SI amended from 80% to 70% to align both.

Prior to the 2019 C/AS2 publication, there was a comment box on guttering and spouting and whether these formed part of the roof projection to determine distance from boundaries. This has now been added back in as Paragraph 5.6.5.

Figure 5.6 was updated to ensure it aligns with 5.7.8.a), sprinklers need to be provided throughout the building to provide roof protection, removing uncertainty between the text and the figure.

In Part 7, Paragraph 7.2 on gas installations now refers to Building Code clause G11, and Paragraph 7.4, previously on luminaires, now refers to clause G9 for electrical fire safety – this is to prevent overlaps and inconsistencies with other code clauses.

C/AS2 also had various proposed amendments to the sections on means of escape and firefighting, which received feedback indicating we need to work closer with the sector. The section on the control of external fire spread was amended to provide consistency with other sections. The section in Part 4 on group sleeping areas was amended to remove inconsistencies and adjustments for now allowing full height partitions while still ensuring a safe means of egress.

Further amendments will be made to the fire compliance documents.

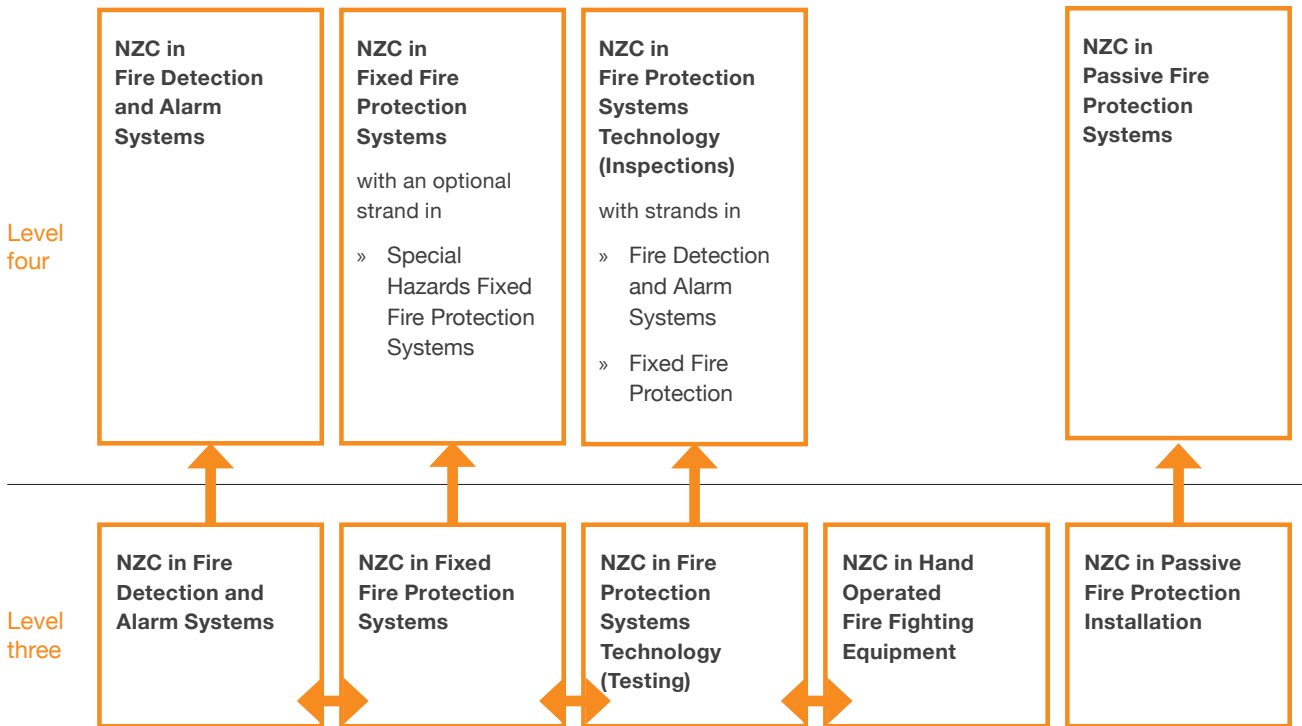
