Membership Process Update

Further to my notes in last month's newsletter, we have now rolled out the new membership process. Part of the new procedure involves our existing members, so, with this in mind, I'd like to explain the process and how and why some potential new members might approach you for an endorsement to their application. All provisional applicants must supply three endorsement forms with their application. To be eligible to endorse someone, you need to:

1. have been a full financial member of FPA NZ for two or more years and
2. be the primary contact for your own company.

By endorsing new members, you are effectively confirming that you know the person or company that is applying and believe they will uphold the ethics and values of the association. Existing members should only provide this endorsement if they are comfortable with that view. Fees Free Update

It is pleasing to see the number of new enrolments in our industry. In fact, it appears we are now the second or third industry in terms of new enrolments, with some 784 learners enrolled to date. This is an impressive number that also brings with it a big obligation for learners to complete the programmes. We are currently working with Competenz to be able to deliver some learners' workshops and additional material to help learners complete their studies. I hope to be able to provide additional updates on this in the coming weeks. We are mindful that many learners are outside of Auckland, so we have plans to ensure these supplementary workshops will be provided online so they can be accessed from anywhere. Note also that the apprenticeship boost has been extended until August 2022.

Changes to Regulations on Trial Evacuations and Training Programmes

(Fire and Emergency New Zealand (COVID-19—Fire Safety, Evacuation Procedures, and Evacuation Schemes) Amendment Regulations (No 2) 2020)

The requirement for building owners to conduct trial evacuations or evacuation training programmes will be reinstated from next Monday, 1 February 2021, provided there are no physical distancing requirements in place for the area in which the building is located. Specific exclusions have been included in the changes to accommodate those buildings which are in use as Managed Isolation and Quarantine Facilities.

Building owners are not expected to resume trial evacuations or evacuation training programmes immediately the changes come into force. To work out when the next trial evacuation or training programme notification is due, you calculate a 6-month period that excludes the time from 25 March 2020 to 31 January 2021.

This means, for example, if a building was due to have a trial evacuation conducted by 10 April, 17 days after the suspension began, there will be a requirement to conduct a trial 17 days after the changes take effect which will mean 17 February 2021. This is provided there are no physical distancing requirements in force.

While it was disappointing that many of our regular attendees couldn't make this morning's meeting, it was great to welcome Pete Gallagher from FENZ to this morning's meeting. Within FENZ, both Pete and Simon Davies have long been supporters of our HOFFE group and they have been instrumental in many initiatives including the fire extinguisher usage survey that resulted in report #148 which is a great but underutilized asset for our industry.

Pete came along bringing us great news, FENZ have identified the NZS4503 review as a priority for them. To help enable this to happen FENZ has put aside some funding specifically for progressing NZS4503's review. With this sort of news on offer I reckon we need to invite him back again!!

Pete also informed the group that FENZ have put out a national internal directive to their staff requesting that they remove foam fire extinguishers from their FENZ stock. These are to be collected and destroyed, Pete pointed out that while this was an internal action it could be misconstrued to be a requirement for foam fire extinguishers to be removed from commercial premises. This "heads up" was given to help avoid the confusion that often can surround such a directive.

Evacuation Consultants SIG Update

Recently we have seen FENZ requiring fire drills to be carried out again. As we engage with those drills, it raises the question of what a fire drill should achieve. Those running drills on a regular basis are aware of the reporting requirements for FENZ. Are those minimal requirements testing / training the occupants as to what a real evacuation may look like? Recently I was asked about fire curtains, with a building occupant stating he had been in many drills within a building but was unaware there was a fire curtain in his area until there was an unwanted alarm. When I have these conversations, it strengthens my belief that we should be running drills with the building in full fire mode where the circumstances allow.

When a fire drill is run with the building fully activated, the occupants are disrupted as part of the drill. This gives us the perfect opportunity to allow other interested parties to test their systems and carry out their relevant checks.

It has been fantastic to see new faces at the SIG meetings. We have also heard some interesting thoughts around new training ideas and of course regular updates from FENZ. Update on the revision of NZS 4510:2008 Fire hydrant systems for buildings

PURPOSE OF THIS UPDATE

The committee revising NZS 4510 has had three meetings to date. Due to the ongoing disruption of COVID-19, the third committee meeting was held via online videoconference on 23rd & 24th February 2021.

This is an update of progress to date, which is intended to be circulated to the committee members, who, in turn, are encouraged to update their nominating organisation on the progress of this project. It needs to be noted that committee deliberations are confidential. This is to ensure, among other things, that committee members are not subjected to undue pressure and that assumptions are not made by members of the public as to what may be published.

Nominating organisations are also encouraged to provide feedback to their committee member(s) on any proposed changes.

COMPLETED & UPCOMING MILESTONES

The project is to be released for public comment in August 2021, with publication due in October 2021.

The following milestones have been completed.

1. Kick off meeting completed, where scope agreed and working groups established
2. Committee meeting 2 has been completed.
3. Committee meeting 3 has been completed.

Upcoming milestone:

Committee meeting 4 is scheduled for 28 & 29th April in Wellington.

SUMMARY OF MAJOR CHANGES PROPOSED

No major changes had been decided on, discussions took place on:

- › the requirements for fire fighter safe access to hydrants,
- › combined sprinkler and riser systems, and
- › systems in areas prone to frost.

One area of significant work remains - an appendix outlining design philosophies for systems which strictly fall outside the remit of the standard. This work is being led by Fire & Emergency.

The exact details of the proposed changes cannot be confirmed until the final draft is presented to the Standards Approval Board and approved.

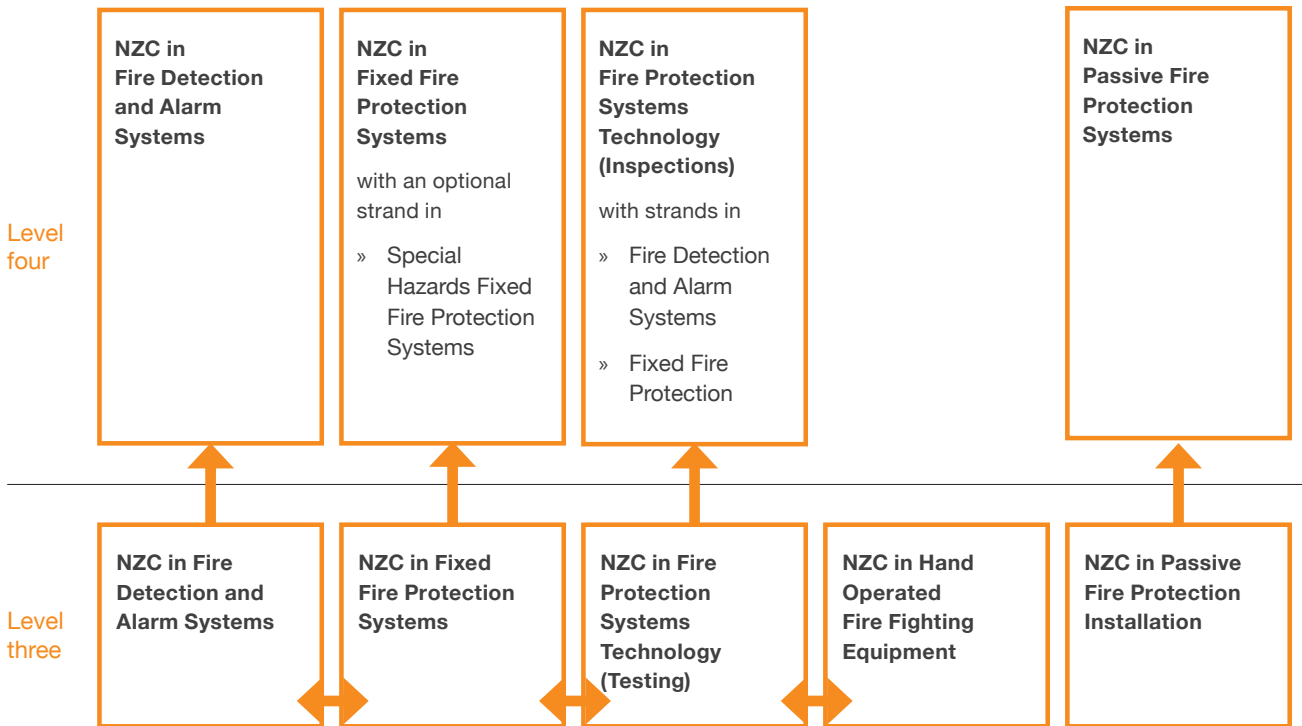
