WELCOME

Welcome to June's newsletter.

In closing the association's financial year out on the 30th of June, I would like to take the opportunity to thank our members for their support and for the positive feedback on the initiatives we have delivered this year. We have made some good progress, and I would like to update you on some of the milestones for the year.

FPANZ Position Statements and Codes of Practice

Many of you would know there were more questions than answers when the country was ordered into lockdown due to COVID-19. We worked hard to get answers from officials on what we could do and how our industry could operate. Based on these answers, we produced position statements and continually updated them as the situation evolved. Our intent with these was to enable our members to get on with their business while we dealt with the officials and asked the pressing questions. Behind the words and advice in the position statements were usually a considerable number of meetings and emails with


multiple organisations. These position statements were well received, and we are pleased so many of you found them useful. Four passive position statements are in the final stages of review and will be released in the next couple of weeks.

Codes of practice have also been a significant area of development for the association, and the coatings working group is in the final stages of signing off the code of practice for the Specification and Application of Intumescent Coatings for the Fire Protection of Structural Steel. We are also well into developing the building interface code of practice and have formed a working group for the next code of practice based on passive penetrations.

Fees Free

While fire qualifications were not initially included in the training subsidy announcement, we actively lobbied both the Tertiary Education Commission and Competenz to have this position reviewed. I am pleased to announce that all level 3 and 4 qualifications are now included in the fees free policy. With recent government budget announcements of free training fees, alongside wage subsidies for employers of apprentices, there has never been a better time to get your staff qualified. From 01 July 2020 to 31 December 2022 all Competenz Fire Protection qualifications will be free for the first two years of level 4 apprenticeships, and all level 3 traineeships. On top of this, there are wage subsidies available under various schemes for employers of apprentices through Work and Income. These subsidies include the Apprenticeship Boost for employers of new and currently enrolled, first and second year apprentices. Stronger Advocation for Industry

We regularly engage with the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment (MBIE) on important policy changes, provide input and direction and advocate for fire protection services to become a licensed trade under the Licensed Building Practitioners (LBP) scheme. We now regularly deliver feedback on policy and provide subject matter experts to advise on behalf of industry. Standards Development

This year saw the completion of the sprinkler standard NZS4541, another significant achievement for the association and members. We are also well into the development phases for NZS4512 Fire Detection and Alarm Systems in Buildings and NZS4514 Interconnected Smoke Alarms for Houses and have signed a contract for NZS4510 Fire Hydrant Systems for Buildings. The continued development of these standards is a significant milestone for the association, and we have never before had so many standards under redevelopment at one time.

HOFFE SIG Update

Our collective efforts have got us down to Covid Level 1 and, while still being cautious, we are approaching normality at a much faster rate than many others. I think most of us are optimistic about the outcomes, so hopefully this, combined with the government backed initiatives, can help us all to recover from the huge financial fallout.

While we have been able to resume our normal service and sales work, the restrictions and protocols we have had to, and generally want to follow, inevitably slow us down. While many are busy playing catch up at present, the fall out will have a long tail. Servicing is generally on a bi-annual or annual basis, therefore planning for what happens in April and May next year is something that we should now bear in mind. Having a huge workload next June after a quiet April and May doesn't make sense so effectively managing this will obviously involve some dialogue with your clients.

Another item that has attracted a bit of attention is a recent fatal incident that is reported by the MAIB to have occurred in the town of Newlyn in England. Unfortunately, an apprentice lost his life while an aerosol fire suppression system was being installed on a fishing vessel. The incident in November last year prompted a Safety Bulletin to be released. An engineer and an apprentice were working in the engine room where two contractors were installing a "condensed aerosol fire extinguishing system". Apparently without warning, the system "inadvertently discharged filling the engine room with a dense cloud of aerosol fire suppressing particles". While the engineer and contractors escaped unscathed the apprentice did not - he could not be resuscitated and was found to have "inhaled a high concentration of suppressant particles".

Many of us service and install fire suppression systems. These are systems we are often familiar with (we may even be certified as agents for these systems), and we may also maintain them on a regular basis. The difference with fire suppression systems

is that unlike fire extinguishers they often do not stop as soon as we release a trigger or handle and can deliver a lot of fire suppression agent in a very short amount of time. The message to take away from this is to be very careful with fire suppression systems - isolate them before you carry out any service or installation work and if you are not sure of what to do, do not proceed and seek assistance.

Aero Fire was recently prosecuted by the Commerce Commission in the Manukau District Court under the Fair Trading Act and fined a total of \$60,000 for false and misleading claims around fire extinguisher servicing. The matters they were held to account for included:

- ▶ Telling customers that their fire extinguishers had a history they did not have e.g. the extinguisher has been pressure tested when it had not.
- ▶ Claiming that extinguishers were installed in line with NZS4503:2005 when they were not.

In sentencing Judge Recordon said the offending was "very possibly dangerous" and "certainly dishonest". Mr and Mrs Singh have agreed to sign court enforceable undertakings to:

- ▶ Not be knowingly involved in the supply of fire safety equipment
- ▶ Not be knowingly involved in offering services connected in any way with fire safety equipment
- ▶ Remove Aero Fire from the Companies Register

Particular mention was made of the following practices:

- ▶ Installation of the wrong type of fire extinguisher, e.g. using a dry powder extinguisher for an oil fire which could cause flash over (referring to cooking oil).
- ▶ Installation in inaccessible locations
- ▶ Insufficient signage
- ▶ Expired and faulty fire extinguishers

HOFFE SIG Update *cont.*

I think one of the most important things to take away from this is in the Commerce Commission media release where it states that “Fire extinguishers must be serviced in accordance with the New Zealand Standard for Hand Operated Fire-Fighting Equipment, NZS 4503:2005”. It unequivocally sets the expectation that this is the minimum level of

service expected and has shown that not meeting this standard can leave you and your company open to prosecution.

Passive Fire Protection SIG Update

PASSIVE FIRE AND NZBC – CLAUSE B2 DURABILITY

We always talk about tested systems, but seldom do we acknowledge ‘durability’ with regard to selection and installation of Passive Fire systems. As contractors, manufacturers, distributors, fire engineers, specifiers, councils and third-party agents we all have a responsibility under NZBC to ensure Clause B2 is satisfied.

Considerations with regard to Passive Fire protection should include:

- » Environment of the finished building – i.e. a swimming pool or heavy corrosive environment
- » Exterior – i.e. exposed to sunlight, frost, rain
- » Coastal – i.e. exposed to sea air, stainless fixings
- » Thermal – i.e. central North Island
- » Compatibility between metals – i.e. Galv & stainless steel, copper pipe reaction
- » Dust - Suitability against substrate – i.e. will the fire stop still adhere over time
- » Shrinkage – i.e. mastic, concrete, and other materials shrink over time
- » Seismic – movement of substrate, service and passive systems
- » Future access – can it be accessed for inspection or maintenance?
- » Future services – is there any risk of damage to the device during future installations?

Just because a particular detail has the appropriate testing for AS1530.4 or Assessment AS4072.1 does

not mean that it is the correct selection as it may not satisfy NZBC B2.

When issuing Producer Statements, we are stating that the works have been completed in accordance with NZBC. Generally, for Passive Fire protection this is specific to C1 – C6 or parts of. It should also be acknowledged & referenced that the works comply with B2. Where BCA’s have an Approved Author system or are reviewing a Producer Statement Author, they should consider the authors knowledge, understanding and demonstration of B2 with regard to Passive Fire protection.

Specific to each aspect of Passive Fire Protection:

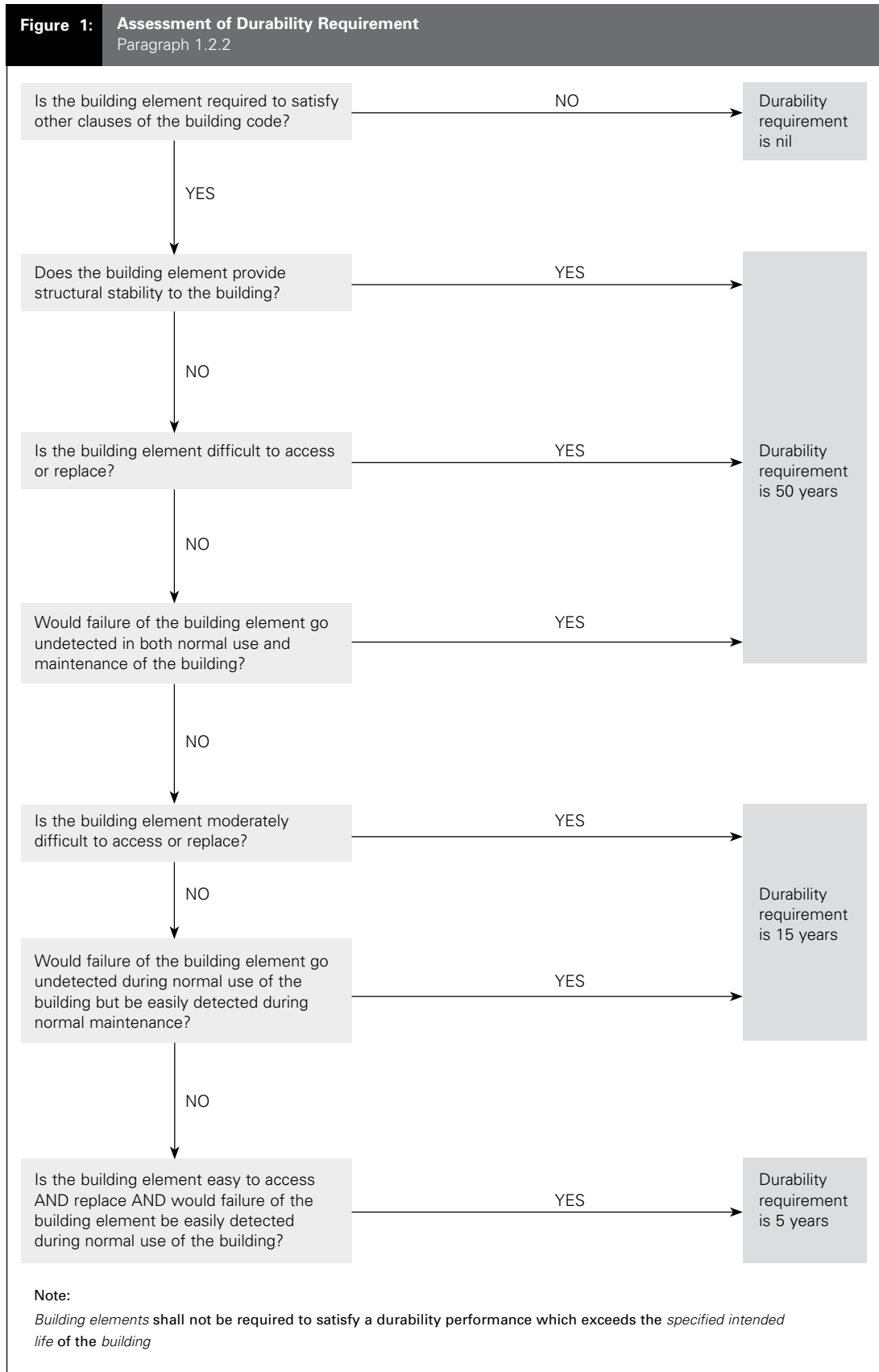
- » Fire rated Doorsets follow a design and QA process that ensures for instance Exterior Grade doors are installed in the correction locations.
- » Intumescent Coatings will under the draft Intumescent Coatings Code of Practice have a section dedicated to corrosion and durability including cross reference with NZS3404.
- » HVAC ducts and dampers are to be cross referenced with AS1668 which includes considerations for B2.
- » Fire Stopping has largely been left out of the microscope with regard to B2

Specifically, B2 provides the following table and flow chart:

Speaker Wiring Work on 100V Evacuation Lines

This is a topic that has come up a number of times over the years.

One of the NZS4512 working committee has obtained a formal answer to this question:

18 June 2020

Speaker wiring work (ES ref 200603-03)
[IN-CONFIDENCE:RELEASE EXTERNAL]

Thank you for your inquiry regarding speaker wiring with respect prescribed electrical work (PEW).

Q: Can fire alarm tech work on 100V evacuation lines?

A: *These speaker circuits are rated to be producing full power when 100VRMS is present. However, audio (background music, paging, fire evacuation etc) has a very high peak-to-average ratio and thus the voltage present is normally well below 30VRMS except for very short duration transients (ie a similar argument for 90VRMS ringing voltage superimposed on -48VDC on PSTN telephone circuits not being treated as prescribed electrical work).*

As speaker wiring is not work on an electrical installation, therefore it is not PEW.

I hope this helps.
