Evacuation Consultants SIG Update

The last few weeks have provided an excellent opportunity to review evacuation schemes and find new ways to deliver training. I have found the level 4 lockdown has encouraged many people to explore the world of video conferencing where they were reluctant before, and enabled us to build relationships at a different level than prior to the pandemic.

We are continuing to work with FENZ and other agencies to ensure that we understand our obligations at each level of this pandemic. I am sure that many of you are preparing to return to sites and discussing how to re-engage projects after several

weeks away from the field. Please keep up to date with the latest position statement from FPANZ and information from FENZ. During level 3 it is unlikely that it is acceptable to carry out trial evacuations as the nature of the event puts individuals in close proximity to each other and there is increased contact with objects such as handrails.

HOFFE SIG Update

Hi folks – I hope you and your families are all safe, well, and that you haven't gone stir crazy during this lockdown. It is an extremely unusual place in which we all find ourselves at this time, but thankfully it is one which is steadily improving. On the 20 April FPA published some guidelines for us to follow which have been developed in line with the advice from MBIE.

With the underlying principal being that **“Workers must work from home where possible, maintain social distancing and that we must not put ourselves or anyone else at risk through our actions or inactions”** the result will inevitably be a marked decrease in servicing work with many clients not wanting to engage our services at this time.

As with alert level 4 we can still carry out refilling and replacement work as required for businesses and services that are allowed to operate under the level

3 conditions. The focus of alert level 3 is to allow additional business activity provided it can be undertaken safely. Businesses cannot offer services which require face to face contact or sustained close contact.

Annual and biannual inspections should not be carried out at this time, they should be deferred unless it is in an environment where the risk has been assessed as low and can be responsibly managed.

Currently it looks likely that we will be under level 3 conditions for at least 2 weeks, under level 2 a high degree of normality will exist and we expect that both annual and bi-annual servicing will recommence

Passive Fire Protection SIG Update

As you will be receiving this newsletter you will all no doubt be in the throes of returning to work using the detailed H&S and operational planning that is required to work under Level 3 conditions.

One thing I am personally thankful for is the fact that we have modern day technology available to us that can really be put to use under these challenging situations. This has been highlighted for a lot of businesses over the past 5 weeks. The Passive SIG for instance has managed to continue to operate SIG meetings with great attendance via Zoom, holding meetings for various actions, sharing information in a prompt manner, online training including NZQA Level 3 Passive Installers and in general we are able to continue with limited loss in momentum. In fact, we have developed new initiatives such as Webinars that will allow us to cast the net to a wider audience.

Another thing I have personally found very valuable through this time is my FPANZ network for information sharing, ideas and keeping in touch with all of the moving parts.

OPERATE SAFELY & REDUCE RISK TO YOUR STAFF

I thought it would be good to cover some of the Level 3 restrictions specifically on Passive Fire Protection to assist us all moving forward. By now we will all have received a wealth of information from Sitesafe/ Worksafe etc regarding operating safely on construction sites. Some additional actions that might help reduce the risk to you and your staff:

1. **Site visits** – keep these to necessary only. If it is not necessary to visit site then don't do so
2. **Sales reps** – keep to phone calls as much as possible. You will do your clients a favour as this is one less person/ risk they need to manage in a day
3. **Sales distribution** – there seems to be a wide range of click and collect arrangements available so therefore visits to shops can be limited
4. **Materials/ Purchasing** – ensure that your team are organized and planning out jobs, materials etc well in advance. This allows your suppliers a fairer chance to have products, stock etc available. No one appreciates last minute rush orders, let alone under Level 3.
5. **Penetration Registers** – plan ahead and have penetration solutions for staff pre-planned and pre-approved prior to site attendance. This forward planning is best practice regardless and will limit queries from site, delays to jobs, repeat work etc.
6. **Inspections** – try to eliminate these as much as possible. Utilize QA photo reports from contractors and staff. Utilize Facetime, Zoom and the likes and co-ordinate virtual site inspections.
7. **QA record keeping** – keep accurate QA records so that the likes of Fire Engineers, BCA, 3rd Party and the like can review from their home office as opposed to site visits (take short videos as well as photos).
8. **Meetings** – With the likes of Zoom, Teams, Loom etc there should be no need for face to face large meetings to be held at all. This is proving a huge time saver for everyone I have spoken to as well
9. **Staff meetings** – try utilizing the likes of Zoom, Facetime etc for staff meetings – if you don't have to bring your entire company together in one space then you are significantly reducing your risks
10. **Aged Care Facilities and Hospitals** – as per FPANZ position statement any work at Aged Care Facilities should be deferred unless absolutely necessary. MBIE, BCA's are making things flexible for the likes of BWOF's so there should be limited reasons for any Passive work occurring inside Aged Care facilities for the time being.
11. **Apartment Buildings (occupied)** – Ensure before any staff plan to visit such buildings that you have clearly identified if any residents are potentially 'vulnerable health' or 'Self isolating'. The last thing you want is to turn up and find such a resident.

- 12. Prioritize work** – assess the health risks for each site/ task and prioritize the work. If it can wait and it has a higher risk then defer that job.
- 13. Shift work** (mornings, evenings, nights, weekends) – consider shift work where available. This may be beneficial to staff with school children and the like. This may allow you a better uncongested and restricted run at work on site
- 14. Ensure sites are ready for you** – ring and communicate with your clients (Main Contractors) that they are definitely ready for you. i.e all 1st fix complete, Gib complete etc – any unnecessary return to site is another human contact health risk
- 15. Tendering** – be careful to ensure pricing considers any new Covid_19 Health and Safety controls such as PPE.
- 16. Vacant building access** – for some clients this is an ideal time for the likes of Passive Remedial works to occur as their spaces will be vacant. (Office buildings etc)
- 17. Downtime work** – prepare a list of downtime work that staff can be doing under Level 3 if you find you have a downturn in productive work.
- 18. PPE** – get sufficient stock in to ensure you have it on a recurring cycle/ order. If your staff are managing the risk correctly you should be going through a lot of disposable PPE such as masks, gloves, overalls etc.
- 19. Mental health** – keep tabs on mental health of staff and colleagues. Not everyone will be coping with this life changing event the same way.
- 20. Communicate** – keep communicating with everyone. The more we talk the more prepared we all are.

I hope everyone is keeping in good health and that businesses and employees have had minimal impact. The challenge isn't over but we are winning the battle.
