## WELCOME

*Welcome to February, and the first newsletter of the year.*

Well, the year has started as the last one finished, BUSY for everyone, and it is no different here at the association's offices. I would like to take this opportunity to brief you on the main things going on over the next couple of months.

### Standards Update

As you will see from the update below, the association is putting significant resources into ensuring our standards remain relevant and fit for purpose and that our members are well represented in any changes. The current commitment is one of the most significant in the past decade.

NZS4541 is due to be published on 17 March, so those in the industry who need to be aware of the changes should ensure they get a copy. We will also be offering

seminars about these changes (see the 'Get it Right' seminar information on page 10).

The second project meeting for NZS4512 and NZS4514 is due to take place in March, and a summary of the milestones is included on page 7 of this newsletter. This is another significant update to a standard that is extensively used in our industry, and I suggest you review the more detailed update to see what's being considered. As stated previously, we have received considerable input from our members at seminars and represent these views in the project meetings.

We are also in development discussions with two other project stakeholders and currently reviewing a proposal to support a project to review and update NZS4510. We are expecting a decision on this to be made within 1–2 months.

Other aspects of the project will focus on the development of marketing material and careers events to promote careers in the fire protection industry to other organisations, schools, universities, and polytechnics because – as we have already identified – the industry struggles to be seen as a career path.

This is a significant project and a longer-term goal for the association and its members, and I encourage you to support it by registering to be part of the pilot so we can grow our industry and supply people at all levels and locations around New Zealand in the future.

### ‘Get it Right’ Seminar Series 2020

Our planning for seminars this year is already well underway. Demand has seen us schedule a fire alarms seminar in Dunedin and sprinkler seminars in Auckland, Rotorua, Wellington, and Christchurch.

The ‘Get it Right’ sprinkler systems seminar is driven by the ongoing changes we face as an industry and the importance of selecting the right products to meet design and standards requirements. The aim of these seminars is to ensure that the industry is continuing to get the latest information and support. The workshop is particularly aimed at those involved in design, fabrication, supply, specification, installation and testing of sprinkler systems. ## Richard Cree celebrates 40 years with Johnson Controls

Richard’s monumental achievement celebrated by the team in Johnson Controls Christchurch, New Zealand

**Richard Cree, senior manager in Electronics Engineering, Fire Detection, recently celebrated 40 years service with the company at the Fire Detection Research & Development (R&D) facility in Christchurch, New Zealand.**

Richard joined Wormald Vigilant in New Zealand in 1979 as a R&D engineer and worked on a number of hardware products before moving on to systems and software development. He was appointed R&D manager in 1985.

After Tyco International acquired Wormald, Richard was appointed manager of the new Vigilant Fire and Evacuation Systems division. Richard grew and ran the Vigilant business, which encompassed R&D, Manufacturing, Product Management and Sales. At this time, Vigilant’s scope of operations grew to include Australia, and Richard received multiple awards for its performance.

Richard has also contributed the development of key fire alarm, evacuation and monitoring standards/codes in Australia and New Zealand (ANZ).

In 2005, Richard oversaw the move of the R&D group’s current premises. He also continued the focus on developing Fire Detection, Evacuation and Brigade Monitoring systems.



Many successful products have been developed during his tenure, including the Centaur II and ASE MkII brigade monitoring systems; the FP4000 and MX1 fire alarms for New Zealand; the F3200, MX4428 and MX1 fire alarms for Australia; and the QE90 and T-Gen2 evacuation systems.

Today, Richard works part-time on local engineering projects and special projects where his experience and expertise can assist, allowing him to continue fostering his passion for engineering.

Richard reflected, “It’s been great to work with technology that has been continually advancing over the years, and to apply this to the protection of life and safety.

“Looking back at some of the electronic components I started with, it is amazing what is available now and the complexity of the designs, but also how adaptable they are to use.

“On the other side, one of the designs I did soon after starting 40 years ago, is still in use in our production facility. This shows the longevity of some of the design work that was done. “

## Passive Fire Protection SIG Update

### LEVEL 3 PASSIVE UPDATE:

Early February and we have over 35 Trainees enrolled with Competenz for the Level 3 qualification. Some companies having enrolled 10 – 13 staff.

This Training qualification is New Zealand's only NZQA recognised qualification for Installers. We often see or hear companies stating that they have 'accredited' 'certified' and 'Qualified' Passive staff. The truth is that until now there has been no recognised qualification or training by NZ's highest training authority body or any other recognised organisation.

Soon you will see Fire Engineers, Councils, Clients and specifiers specifically asking for proof of this

level of training as a minimum. Those companies that have been early on the uptake will have a running advantage over those that have not.

# NZS 4512/14 Revision Project Update

The first committee meeting was held on 16 & 17 December 2019 in Wellington.

Eight working groups were formed to explore specific topics in detail:

- › SWG1 – Visual Alerting Devices (VADs)
- › SWG2 – NZS 4514 review
- › SWG3 – Wireless Detection Technology
- › SWG4 – Equipment to Overseas Standards
- › SWG5 – Unprotected spaces
- › SWG6 – Aspirated detection
- › SWG7 – Security
- › SWG8 – Documentation

Meeting 2 is to be held on 23 & 24 March 2020, again in Wellington.

Assuming steady progress is maintained, it is currently hoped to commence an 8-week public consultation in July/August, with the updated standards being published early in 2010.

## SUMMARY OF MAJOR CHANGES PROPOSED

The following major key changes/ additions to NZS 4512 are currently envisaged:

- › It was noted that the committee strongly supports the possibility of fire contracting becoming a licensed trade and is proposing to strengthen provisions around qualifications and competence to support such an initiative.
- › Changes will be made throughout the standard to reflect changes in the New Zealand Building Code (NZBC) Compliance Documents, building legislation, and associated building documentation.
- › There will be updates to and expansion of citations of international standards. The extent of this is being investigated by a standard working group. It was resolved not to mandate the use of fire rated cabling anywhere additional.
- › Numerous minor improvements to the existing text have been proposed and are being worked through.
- › It has been decided in principle to include specific provisions for wireless-based fire detection and alarm equipment. A standard working group is considering the details of this.
- › Additions are being considered to more fully provide for the greater use of visual alerting devices throughout a building. A standard working group is considering the details of this.

A working group is considering the extent of changes required to NZS 4514.

# Tauranga City Council Water Supplies

**A number of contractors have approached us following reports that Tauranga City will not allow boosted water supplies to be directly connected to their reticulation system.**

**We met with Council and discussed this.**

There are a number of potential issues with the connection of pumps directly to the infrastructure, especially if they induce high design flows in their reticulation systems.

One example raised was the impact of the flow testing being carried out for a new major retail development in Tauranga, dislodged a large amount of natural minerals into their reticulation system. It took several days of contractor flushing and normal water usage for the water to return to normal clarity. While Tauranga City's website advises that the discoloured water that occurs during hydrant testing does not pose a health concern, this does impact on the ability to use water in some industrial and food manufacturing industries.

Another example was issues with the Pressure Reducing Valves used in areas such as Papamoa, to protect the Asbestos Cement mains, which are rated at a maximum working pressure of 600kPa. The control valve bonnet volume is in the order of 14L, which enters and leaves the valve through a very small orifice. The network in this area has one entry point, and These valves take some 10 minutes to open and close. Hence, if there are large draw offs in testing large fire pumps, and the pressure reducing valves open, when the flow testing is completed, the mains can be over-pressurised.

In line with many councils, Tauranga's financial capacity to upgrade infrastructure is constrained. To extend the life of their network, they are planning on a program to reduce the pressures in their network. Those designing sprinkler systems should plan on the pressure being reduced to a maximum of 300kPa static pressure.

In summary, consultants and contractors designing sprinkler systems in Tauranga City need to note the following:

- › Large volume fire pumps are unlikely to be allowed to directly connect to their network.
- › Smaller fire pumps may be connected, after discussion with Council.
- › Designers should future proof their designs to cater for a future water supply pressure reduction.

### NZS4541:2020

NZS4541:2020 is due to be published on 17 March. This seminar will introduce you to the provisions of the new standard, and will place an emphasis on the new seismic resilience requirements of the standard.

The changes to the seismic provisions are ground-breaking, and will require a new approach to how the designs are carried out, documented, and installed. The day will conclude with a workshop session, to allow designers to have hands-on training in the new provisions.

### EARTHQUAKES

Following recent earthquakes events in NZ (Christchurch, Wellington and Kaikoura) the building industry is facing increasing pressure to design to protect the building and occupants against earthquake damage.

Generally, sprinkler systems have performed admirably in these events, however there has been some criticism of how we are designing our seismic bracing systems. The playing field has changed, and the construction sector is expecting more from the fire industry.

The presenters will outline what will now be expected to ensure that systems can be certified.
