HOFFE SIG Update

Hi folks,

Well winter is starting to bite, temperatures are dropping and it's getting a bit cold and miserable in many parts of the country. Unfortunately for us some of our clients attitudes can also get a little cold and miserable, might be worth reminding them that too hot can also be problem and but we can help them in that area!!

Anyway I was working with a company on an article for a magazine the other day when a report from earlier this year about a well-intentioned boatie caught my eye. The report was about a vessel which was coming back towards port when a fire broke out in the engine room, unfortunately for him his fire extinguishers had been installed in the engine room to protect it which meant due to the fire he couldn't get to them. He ended up in the water watching the vessel burn to the water line, after reaching land he was picked up 1 ½ hours later with a bit of hypothermia and some mild burns. I imagine it would have been a heart-breaking sight watching your investment burn to the waterline and many emotions would have been going through your head as the fire consumes your boat. You can't help thinking that with the proper fire equipment properly located as per maritime rule 42B57 (also references NZS4503) there is a good chance it could have ended up very differently???

When we put the article together, we included the advice that when servicing and selecting fire equipment a company that is a member of the FPA New Zealand should be used. This is because responsible member service companies who employ truly "competent people" will know that as per NZS 4503:2005 section 2 we are required to certify the equipment as well as "ensure that the fire-fighting equipment can be easily accessed in

a fire situation" (2.3), also that "each fire extinguisher shall be located in a conspicuous,

readily accessible and suitably marked position" (3.3). It is worth noting that the standard also dictates "upon installation, commissioning as detailed in this standard shall take place to ensure that the equipment is in fully operational condition" (2.7). It further goes on to state in 2.8.3.2 that "the type, size, rating, location and identification of the equipment in, or on the property shall be recorded either on a site plan or by other means clearly describing the equipment and its location.

Regardless of the industry the installation of the fire equipment has to be thought out having regard for the nature of the risk(s) and work to be performed. This is why standards, Codes of Practice and regulations exist. I am sure we have all been to client's premises and had to explain why the fire extinguisher/detector or fire blanket should not be installed where the risk is located but rather adjacent to it. We are generally in an environment where rules are enforced reactively rather than proactively, this means that only once there has been an incident will the powers that be investigate but when they do and the finger pointing starts often an example will be made of someone or of someone's company, none of us want to be that example!!!

Passive Fire Protection SIG Update

It cannot go un-noticed that the technical requirements demanded by BCA's and fire engineers have increased dramatically over the last 3 or so years which in our book is a good thing!

We have more and more fire testing taking place, a new IANZ accredited fire test laboratory opening in Auckland and the

level of detail in manufacturers data has improved.

This is all good news for industry, we still have much to do, but the message is positive, our industry is on the right track!

Evacuation Consultants SIG Update

Recently, I've been asked what constitutes a complete evacuation drill. Like most of us, I've witnessed, run and participated in a lot of drills – every setting and its occupants are likely to be at least slightly different to the last, so it's reasonable to see some variation in what a successful drill looks like. But as Evacuation Consultants, are we effectively assessing whether the methods we choose are best suited to a particular situation.

One person stated that if they are running a drill in an apartment setting, then they may run the scenario of a fire being in one of the apartments, and it is sufficient to evacuate the occupants of that single apartment, shut the door and the sprinklers will take care of it, alternatively the hush button is used - so that is the end of the exercise. Is this okay?

Another scenario I have been presented with is to activate the trial evacuation key for a building with staged evacuation to complete the fire drill. Typically, these buildings are fitted with RDU/ mimic panels that the staff are trained to read prior to acting on the alarm, however when the evacuation key is used these displays show no data. Is this okay?

I would imagine that many people have an opinion and thoughts about an acceptable fire drill, after all for many

any and ble any

occupants of a building they may never been part of a genuine evacuation, and are happy for the drill create minimum disruption to their organisation or workplace.

Next time you are witnessing, running or part of an evacuation drill ask yourself what am I gaining from this exercise, if this were a genuine event how would the occupants of the building manage or be managed. There are many genuine events happening each week that often don't make the media, it is important that we don't treat drills as another tick box exercise.

I look forward to seeing you at our next meeting on the 11th November 2019.

Inspectorate SIG Update

For those installing fire alarms, we all know the requirements for getting a fire alarm index approved by the New Zealand Fire Service.

However, have we taken the time to consider what the fire alarm index is for, and what Fire Emergency New Zealand may use the index for.

Obviously, the index provides FENZ personal with an indication of the building outline, and main entrance points to the building. Locations of stairs and the location of other fire alarm systems such as Gas Discharge Systems are also identified.

But what additional information would be useful for FENZ personal to perform their job in an emergency?

Yes, NZS4512:2010 lists the requirements for the location of an index and of what is required to be identified on the fire alarm index. However, there are situations where Engineers or Specifiers may request additional information to be presented on the index over and above what is required by NZS4512. The following examples are of additional information that could be critical to FENZ personal in an emergency:

- Location of the main switchboard to enable power to be shut off to a building if required.
- Location of the LCD display on the fire alarm panel.
- Location of isolation devices for the likes of solar panels or UPS Systems
- Location of Ammonia or Dangerous Good Stores.
- Location of Gas or Fuel Shutoffs.

The fire alarm index location is normally the location of the fire service attendance point. Why would we not use this to



provide as much information to FENZ personal as possible to make their job safer as well? Perhaps this could be looked at during the next revision of NZS4512.

On another topic, the location of fire alarm panels in single zone systems. The NZ Building Code Document C/AS2 Clause A3 Part 6, Information for Fire Fighters says:

"6.2 If Fire Alarm or Sprinkler Systems are installed, the control panel shall be located in a position close to the Fire and Emergency attendance point and in accordance with NZS4512, NZS4515, and NZS4541 as appropriate"

Point to ponder – Is locating the fire alarm panel in a cupboard a suitable location for fire service access? Or is locating the fire panel in the workshop above the oily rags the best location for it? Maybe some further discussion during the NZs4512 revision may result in some changes to this.
