HOFFE SIG Update

I trust you are all well and that business is good, for us it has been a busy month with some interesting things happening in the industry. We have seen some good initiatives being promoted such as the Virtual Reality Fire Training being promoted by Fire and Emergency. We all know that ideally everyone would receive hands on live fire training, equally we know that for various reasons this is not always possible and that an effective alternative could be a great asset that could increase public safety.

Another determination from our discussions this month though this time with Worksafe, was around the role that some of the alternatives to fire extinguishers such as the various types of gadgets that you throw at fires play. The first point is that they are not Fire Extinguishers although a quick search of the internet shows they are actively promoted both overseas and within New Zealand as being “fire extinguishers”. We thought this must be wrong, so we asked Worksafe for their determination on these products being promoted as fire extinguishers. They confirmed that they are not classified as fire extinguishers nor do they consider that they can be deemed to have any standing as part of the fire protection coverage for a commercial premise or a place of work. An example was given of a “Hyster” which had several of these fitted and the question was asked is this vehicle deemed to have fire extinguisher coverage, the reply was no it does not.

There was also some discussion over the way it activates, the debate centred around what seems to be an explosive reaction when this type of device is subjected to either heat (220degrees C° or more) or direct flame. This violent reaction caused some debate over its suitability as a first aid fire fighting tool, which is intended to aid public safety. Also of concern was determining what accepted fire equipment standard if any, these devices were manufactured to, certainly not a AS/NZS standard.

Interestingly some of the product marketing states that like many “multipurpose dry chemical powder” extinguishing agents they must be kept away from moisture as it “may cause the product to not function properly”. It further states that the device “is not waterproof but somewhat resistant to moisture, steam and water.” Taking into account the fact that moisture can potentially impact on the performance of this equipment it seems bizarre that the manufacturers and distributors websites both claim no maintenance inspections are necessary.

Part of the classification problem seems to be that they are not reliant on either a pressurized cartridge or stored pressure for propellant pressure, they rely on a pyrotechnic detonator which once activated produces a 120db – 138db bang. The Health and Safety at Work (Hazardous Substances) Regulations 2017 contain many references to obligations of PCBU’s (Person Conducting Business or Undertakings) many of which relate to the importation and use of pyrotechnic devices (section 9) perhaps this is where these devices fall. Either way it seems very loose at present.

We have also had Worksafe state to us that any instances where it can be confirmed that fire extinguishers are being imported into the country which are not compliant and/or have not been given product clearance as required the company will be prosecuted once this can be verified. The afore-mentioned regulations require the clearance to be undertaken and would be used by Worksafe in this instance.

The Passive SIG Coatings group have had another two meetings since our last newsletter and are making great head way in the production of the new FPANZ technical guide for fire protection coatings in New Zealand.

Work on the new NZQA installers qualification is ongoing - draft information flows back and forth through the working group and the course is coming together nicely!

The Passive Equipment Register has received two new firestopping manufacturer/supplier applications which is great news – there only remains the odd few who appear to be holding out joining the register. Fingers crossed they see the benefits and join in the not too distant future.

SIG meeting attendance continues to grow which is testament to the good work we are doing within Industry.

The most obvious change I am seeing post Grenfell globally is the demand for detailed test data to be presented to fire engineers, specifiers and building certifiers at an early stage of any project involving passive fire protection. The days of hiding behind

“sorry I can’t show you test data as its confidential IP” are long gone in my opinion. North America has had the UL directory for many years which clearly demonstrates how manufacturers have tested their products, Certifire has done the same in UK. I can understand some reluctance by manufacturers not wanting to show other manufacturers their test data but to use IP as a reason when trying to understand and specify a system which will have an impact on fire safety just doesn’t make sense to me!

Manufacturers should be the only “go to” – for clear, concise professional advice and guidance on their products, how they should be installed and how they were tested.

If we want to raise the life safety bar within New Zealand surrounding passive fire protection – we need to provide more clarity!

Inspectorate SIG Update

I have recently had questions raised around the substitution of smoke detectors with heat detectors as well as a question in respect of As-Built documentation.

SUBSTITUTION OF SMOKE DETECTORS WITH HEAT DETECTORS

NZS 4512:2010 Clause 405.1.3 states that to reduce unwanted fire alarm activations, smoke detectors may be replaced with heat detectors (or sprinklers) for up to a maximum of 30% of the area of the firecell.

However, what can be done if the usage of the building is not suitable for the installation of smoke detection? Where Type 4 fire detection and alarm system was specified in a building that was not suitable for the installation of smoke detection, we have seen heat detection installed, often with little understanding of why smoke detection was originally specified.

Smoke detection is specified for several reasons and, by substituting with heat detection, the fire design is more than likely compromised. If the building usage precludes the installation of the specified fire safety system, then the fire design may need to be revised, the building may need to be redesigned with additional exits to get over travel distances, or additional modifications may need to be made to ensure the specified system works in the intended environment.

We have had situations where the inspection has failed and the contractor has had to go back to the fire engineer to get the fire report revised. The final outcome may be a fire safety system for the office area (Type 4) and a fire safety system for the warehouse (Type 3) or a similar solution but this raises the question as to why does it take until the end of the project for the issues to be identified? By then, the project has had a fire design completed, been tendered, the installation has been designed, possibly a variation has been agreed to in respect

of installing additional heat detectors due to coverage differences, installation completed, commissioning completed, and then inspected. How has it managed to get through all these checks for the issues only to be identified at the final inspection?



Further related food for thought: In the scenario of say, an apartment building where you exit through the kitchen area, if you are permitted to substitute a smoke detector for a heat detector within 5 metres horizontally from a cooking appliance (NZS4512:2010 Clause 405.1.3.d), how do you get compliance when under no circumstance are you permitted to substitute smoke detectors for heat detectors in exit ways internal to the building (NSZ 4512:2010 Clause 405.1.3.h.iv)?

AS BUILT DOCUMENTATION

Both NZS 4541 and NZS 4512 require the supply of As Built documentation at the completion of the project. But what is the definition of As Built? As Built documentation reflects all the changes that have been made to the installation since the time of the original installation documentation. For sprinkler systems this also affects hydraulic calculations, block plans and As Built drawings. For fire alarms, this affects Configuration Files, Battery Calculations, Evacuation Amplifier Loadings, and As Built Drawings. If the specification has changed since the original version, an As Built specification may be required.

Not only are these required to be completed for new installations, they are also required for any alterations / extensions. They form an important and valuable part of the documentation that inspectors are required to receive and review.



Back Flow Device Maintenance

Watercare have provided the following photographs to the Association of a back flow prevention device that their auditors discovered.

This was on a town's main connection to a sprinkler system. Their observations included:

- › The devices don't appear to be on a testing schedule.
- › The bypass is switched off at both valves.
- › Despite being switched off (as shown in picture on the right) the bypass backflow device is actually on backwards.



- › There are significant signs of rust and corrosion on the main valve, consistent with a damp environment or a history of flooding.
- › The electrics on the alarm don't appear to be completely insulated. With low voltage dc currents, this could potentially lead to stray current corrosion of any underground steel pipe.
