DZ 4541 is now available for public comment

DZ 4541:2019 (COMMITTEE P4541)

Automatic fire sprinkler systems

NZS 4541 Automatic fire sprinkler systems provides an integrated set of rules for the design, installation, and maintenance of sprinkler systems so that systems reliably protect against the loss of life and minimise property damage from fire.

The key changes proposed in the draft are:

1) The provisions for seismic resilience have been rewritten to reflect the requirements of NZS 1170.5:2004 Structural design actions – Part 5: Earthquake actions – New Zealand. This will require that the seismic design forces in NZS 4541 standard reflect those in NZS 1170.5, instead of the previously de facto design acceleration of 1.0g. In some buildings, the required design loads will be lower, while in other buildings, the design loads will be considerably higher. A maximum design acceleration of 3.6g is being proposed.

2) One proposed change that will impact on manufacturers and importers of sway bracing components is that seismic bracing elements will need to be listed by a sprinkler system certifier (SSC). The proposed listing standard is an ANSI standard, FM 1950:2016 Seismic Sway Braces for Pipe, Tubing and Conduit, or an equivalent standard.

The committee notes that, while the FM Approvals standard will meet the requirements of this standard, verification of compliance from accredited testing laboratories will allow listings of seismic bracing elements by a SSC following other criteria that meet the requirements of the standard.

3) A proposal to combine hydrants and sprinklers in tall buildings in order to add resilience and potentially reduce cost.

4) Another significant change is a set a requirement that work on a sprinkler system is carried out, or supervised by, suitably qualified personnel. The acceptable qualifications are likely to be NZQA qualifications, or those accessed as being equivalent to them.

5) There are also significant changes being proposed to pump speed control requirements, due to the complexity of the design solutions being promoted by industry.

We are now making the draft available for public comment for a period of 8 weeks to allow comments on draft NZS 4541 Automatic fire sprinkler systems. All comments submitted during this period are reviewed by the standards development committee before the standard is balloted on.

A little over twelve months since the revised evacuation regulations were introduced, I think it is fair to say that we are seeing impact on how we operate. There is a lot more focus on how the building will be used, and designing it to be fit for purpose. This strengthens the suggestion that design teams and project managers should be engaging evacuation consultants at the very early stages of any development.

With evacuation consultants engaged at this early stage the evacuation scheme can be developed from the beginning of the project, making the application process and communication with FENZ a lot easier, there is also potential this may result in cost saving.

I think there are still mixed thoughts within the industry about this, so it is up to the evacuation consultants to show the project and design teams how they can be of assistance.

HOFFE SIG Update

Hi everyone,

I trust you are all well and that business is also going well. In the last month I have received a bit of feedback regarding the activities of some companies that are representing themselves as being NZQA qualified for carrying out service work yet their service technicians have not completed a qualification to any level. Some of these companies may also offer other services while on site and some of these services may be in areas other than fire.

Of concern is that either they seem to believe that having completed unit standards 3271 and 4647 (unit standard certificates shown as evidence to clients) they are qualified to carry out service work on fire equipment and give qualified advice to clients on this life safety equipment!! While these unit standards are required to complete a qualification, on their own they are not a qualification and a person who has been accredited with these unit standards does not meet the definition of a “Competent Person” as defined in NZS4503:2005.

Part of the criteria required in NZS4503 for a Competent Person includes relevant industry training, experience, requisite tools, equipment, parts, information (including the manufacturer’s installation/service manual) and to be capable of carrying out the inspection, maintenance or testing requirements of this standard. Many of these aspects of the definition would stop most people from claiming compliance as a “Competent Person” let alone the last sentence of the definition. This definition also states “**Qualification** to an applicable industry programme recognized by the New Zealand Qualifications Authority is an acceptable

means of compliance with this requirement.” Given that you cannot claim to have a Qualification unless you have completed the unit standards and been accredited with a grade sufficient to be awarded the qualification how can you claim to be qualified to any level based on 2 unit standards?

Unfortunately, while there are plenty of good operators out there these operators tend to bring our industry into disrepute which is generally the point at which Scott and I get to hear about it. The other potential consequence is that the clients although acting in good faith may have equipment that may not operate or operate as intended and they may also have non-compliant fire equipment. I have had instances reported to me where fire extinguishers that are due for their hydro-test have not been tested, units needing a refill have been certified, wet chemical units in commercial kitchens that are only a few years old replaced with other types of fire extinguishers which are without F ratings.

While no one likes regulation, it seems to me that we need to not only tighten up the definition of “Competent Person” but also the powers that be need to talk to industry more and weed out those who are not acting ethically. While generally these companies are also not members of the FPA it is also worth remembering that our industry is about life safety which is kind of important!!!

Inspectorate SIG Update

The Fire Protection Association is now maintaining a number of approved product registers. These registers are designed to provide an industry resource on products that have been tested and approved for use either in certain applications like Passive, Hand Operated Fire Fighting Apparatus or approved for use as part of a fire alarm or fire sprinkler system.

I cannot talk too much on the passive products or the Hand Operated Fire Fighting Apparatus registers, apart from these are continuing to grow in size which is an acknowledgement that the suppliers view these as a valuable resource for our industry.

The fire sprinkler register lists approved fire sprinklers for use on fire sprinkler systems within New Zealand. Apart from sprinkler pipework and some range pipe hangers, we should be able to ascertain that all fire sprinklers used in a fire sprinkler system are listed on this approved product register. Generally, fire sprinklers have been through a thorough testing and listing process overseas before they reach the New Zealand market.

Fire alarm equipment goes through a similar process to the fire sprinkler equipment. Approval of products is either through an overseas listing or through an independent testing laboratory. Different manufacturers design their fire panels in different ways, and while they are all tested

against the requirements of NZS4512, each manufacturer has their own requirements. Each manufacturer tests their equipment against certain types of smoke detectors to confirm their adequacy for use with their particular panels. The manufacturers then provide the FPA with a listing of approved smoke detectors for each of their alarm panels. If a manufacturer does not list a particular type of smoke detector for use on their panels, it cannot be used. The process of using a fire panel from one manufacturer, and smoke detectors from a different manufacturer or supplier, is not permitted. Unless the smoke detectors are approved for use on the particular fire panel the system cannot be certified. If the smoke detector product code does not show up under the listing of the fire panel, it is not approved for use with that panel.

There may be the temptation to “Parallel Import” smoke detectors. Again, unless the panel manufacturer has provided approval for the use of the smoke detectors, they are regarded as a non-approved smoke detector and cannot be used. We are dealing with the lives of other people. Let’s be sensible about our decisions.

MBIE funds over 120 building standards for free download

› Building Controls Update 250

To remove barriers to achieving compliance in the building system, over 120 building standards are now available for free download.

These have been funded by the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment (MBIE) to make it easier to comply with the Building Code.

Standards New Zealand, and MBIE as the building system regulator, are committed to improving access to building standards that make a difference to the wellbeing of New Zealanders.

The selected standards are ones that directly help demonstrate compliance with the Building Code, resulting in safe and well-constructed buildings and homes.

MBIE has acted on the concerns of building practitioners that the cost of standards can be a barrier to applying best practice. In December 2017, we made five prominent building standards and a handbook available free of charge, which attracted over 15,000 downloads in the last 18 months.

New Zealand is now one of the few countries in the world providing free access to building standards.
