WELCOME

Welcome to November's newsletter

Well, the end of the year is rapidly approaching. Feedback from members indicates there is still no let-up in the workload, as is the case with our own industry projects. The launch of the new level 3 passive fire protection installers qualification is an example of how the input of our members helps drive the industry forward. Qualifications are also a critical part of the framework required to get to the end goal of a regulated fire protection industry. Some of these projects can take years before the final outcome is achieved. However, as the year draws to a close, it is a significant achievement for FPANZ and the passive members that a formal qualification is now available.

Next month, I'll summarise the main outputs for the year and some of our goals for next year. These were also touched on during our AGM on 28 November. We also report on many of our deliverables in the AGM report that we produce for our members. A copy of this is sent electronically to each primary contact at member companies before the AGM, and this year a printed copy will also be in the mail as you read this.

Update on Council and SIG Positions

As per our constitution, we rotate all positions on the national council. As such, we usually have a few positions we need to seek nominations for. This year, we were seeking nominations for president, two council positions, and three special interest group (SIG) chair positions. The incumbents in these positions are eligible to seek additional terms but—as part of the rotation—must step down and seek re-election. Where only a single nomination is received for a position, no voting is required, but if more than one eligible candidate stands, a vote must take place. The results this year are as follows:

This can also mean a limited number of people put their names forward for nomination. I would like to take the opportunity to thank all the members of our council and board for their substantial input, in terms of both time and effort during 2019, and I welcome their contribution to shaping the future next year.

NZS4512 Update

The first meeting of the NZS4512 project committee will be on 16 December. FPANZ have put forward three representatives covering the following groups: inspection, contractors and general representatives. This representation will give us a strong voice within the committee representing the specialist groups

EPA Fire Fighting Foam Submission

A small working group of industry experts was formed to review the proposal to amend the Fire Fighting Chemicals Group Standard 2017 by the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). This group standard regulates the import, manufacture, use, storage and disposal of fire-fighting chemicals. It currently prohibits fire-fighting foams containing PFOS (perfluorooctane sulfonic acid) and PFOA (perfluorooctanoic acid). The proposed amendments add further restrictions on fire-fighting foams containing fluorinated organic compounds (PFAS chemicals).

Given the significant implications for the fire protection industry, end users and owners with systems containing these substances, we have made a written submission on behalf of FPANZ members. We have also asked to attend and make a submission in person to ensure our message is heard. Inspectorate SIG Update

Recently we have had a number instances of underground pipework not being flushed correctly. Please refer to this article previously published by Stephen Ridder, Fire Protection Consultant, Aon New Zealand.

Water Supply Flushing

The success of a fire sprinkler system to adequately contain, or control, a fire is dependent upon at least the minimum required volume of water being discharged from the sprinkler heads. Inadequate flushing has the ability to drastically impact the performance of the sprinkler system. Inspectors around the country find evidence during commissioning flow testing that flushing was inadequate as evidenced by waste materials found in the flow meter after testing or by the telltale sign of stones 'pinging' inside the flow tube during testing.

The types of materials found may lead to many different types of system failure. Firstly on a high volume sprinkler system waste materials may

obscure the strainer impairing the supply of water to the sprinkler system. Secondly waste materials may block the cooling system filter on a diesel fire pump leading to engine failure. Thirdly hard objects such as stones may damage or jam the pump impellor, isolation valves, backflow preventer, check valves and alarm valves. Fourthly larger objects much lodge within the distribution pipes severely reducing the flow of water to the sprinkler heads. Lastly smaller objects may foul within the orifice of the sprinkler head obscuring the free flow of water through the sprinkler head.

It should also be noted that within our trade flushing has a different meaning to that of the water supply industry where flushing is to remove any traces of chorine. Chlorination/sterilization certificates are not evidence of high volume flushing as required by NZS4541:2013.

Flushing needs to be completed before the sprinkler system is connected to the underground pipe to avoid the possibility of foreign materials being washed into the sprinkler system. While the flushing certificate in NZS4541:2013 gives minimum flow rates the simplest method is to simply discharge from the open end with the water supply operating at full flow, ie sluice valve wide open.

The requirement to flush all underground pipe is a requirement of NZS4541:2013 irrespective of whose contractual responsibility the installation of the pipe is. It is our view that the onus rests upon the entity submitting the form 1 documents to advise the underground contractor what is required. We would

suggest that before connecting the valve set to the water supply the fire contractor obtains a copy of the flushing certificate or undertakes their own flushing.
