FireNZ Update

The full-panel Q&A session on Friday morning was also very successful and clearly allowed a far greater level of interaction with the audience than is possible during standard one-on-one Q&A sessions.

We will also soon send a link to the presentations that we have permission to release, but do note that some speakers have not given permission for their work to be released.

NZS4512 Update

We are now approaching the final stage of the NZS4512 update, which involves a presentation to the Standards NZ board next

week. I am hoping this will see us gain full approval for the project, which will enable us to get things moving and confirm project dates. As with other updated standards, the working committee will be selected via a democratic process, so we will call for submissions, and a selection panel will review applicants to ensure they have the necessary skills.

Reform of Vocational Education (ROVE) Update

Many of you know that worked on a submission to this critical government proposal to restructure the

vocational education system. Updates have since been provided, and the government reforms will see workforce development councils being established and the current industry training organisation (ITO) structure dismantled. This is a very important and complex topic for our industry, and the government has provided little time for true engagement or for stakeholders to get to grips with the pros and cons of such drastic changes. To this end, we have included further updates on page "Reform of Vocational Education" on page 8 from our current ITO, Competenz. I strongly encourage you to read them, ask questions, make submissions and where possible – attend the workshop Competenz are running on Friday 4 October, further details will be emailed to our members directly. I apologise for the short notice, but the timelines are not driven by Competenz or FPANZ.

AGM Update

Just a place holder for your calendar: our AGM will be on Thursday 28 November. We will send details about the venue, etc. soon. We will also be producing our annual report and running elections for council and board positions as required and will send further details on this process closer to the time.

Careers and Industry Development Pilot

I am pleased to announce that the board have approved the careers and industry development project, which will see us developing both marketing collateral and a process to bring a new generation of school leavers into the fire protection industry. We will also be engaging a contractor to meet with

careers advisors and carry out a pre-screening process with school leavers before matching them with members seeking new trainees. I will update you further on this project in future newsletters, but the main push will be from the start of 2020, and the project will run for six months. This is a new initiative, and I encourage any members seeking to bring on new cadets/trainees to be part of this process.

Codes of Practice

It is pleasing to note that, as you read this, the coatings code of practice (CoP) will be in its final development stage, which is the stakeholder engagement and comment phase. Once this is complete, the association will be able to release its third CoP. The group working on this has undertaken some really amazing work, and the benefits will be far reaching.

Work is also progressing well on the building systems and interface CoP, which will be released next year. It is shaping up to be another important and useful document.

Evacuation Consultants SIG Update

Our draft code of conduct document has now been released for feedback; I look forward to incorporating your responses into the document prior to us reviewing this at the next meeting.

This month I would like to mention hazardous substances. When application is made for an evacuation scheme, the author often either overlooks the hazardous substances section, or does not have enough data to be able to understand the levels of substances within the building.

Substances that meet the threshold for notification may include paint, solvents and LPG. FENZ need to know these quantities so they can provide an appropriate response and to ensure the safety of their firefighters. Depending on what is in the building this may also affect the evacuation procedure and assembly points. The threshold quantities for different classification of hazardous substances are listed in the 'Schedule 3' Appendix of the Evacuation Regulations.

It is always frustrating when a scheme application gets rejected, so make it a routine practice to ask your client what



hazardous substances they have on site. If you are not clear what information to provide about a Hazardous Substances (or any other section) contact your local fire risk management officer who will be able to advise. Don't forget this information is to help with effective evacuation and firefighting —having large quantities of hazardous substances won't result in non-approval of a scheme.

Finally, I thought that FireNZ 2019 was another great event, with some insightful talks from the excellent line up of speakers. I am looking forward to the event in Rotorua next year.

HOFFE SIG Update

Well, the days are getting longer, the sun is up by 6am and daylight saving is nearly upon us. That is almost as important as the rugby world cup now underway in Japan!

Anyway, on to the HOFFE stuff. Strangely I have found that there is a lack of feedback from those who stand to benefit most from the initiatives we as the HOFFE group are promoting, like the "Fire Extinguisher Register" and the "Service Code of Practice". Despite the FPA having sent the document out for comment little feedback has been received on this. This is strange, as they are potentially important industry documents that will benefit our members!

We also continue hearing from various industry sectors about companies seeing fire equipment servicing as a job that can be carried out by people who are lacking in relevant industry experience. It is worth noting that this can also have implications for insurance, some insurance companies have been telling their clients to be careful as some test and tag operators do not meet the definition in NZS4503:2005 of a "Competent Person" and therefore are not qualified to carry out F.E. inspections or to make recommendations. Some see this as simply an add-on while they are on site carrying out other work, rather than a job that should be carried out by experienced service personnel to an industry standard. I often hear stories about people looking for gauges on CO2 extinguishers, servicing fire extinguishers without removing them from the wall bracket, installing them under an incorrect "For Use" blazon, not removing the safety pins from the handles



in order to check they aren't bent and that the assembly moves freely (the old seal is often the visual giveaway). There are sometimes fairly savvy people watching, checking or following, not to mention other companies looking for work so make sure your work measures up as we are often questioned by the public about the workmanship of service companies.

At a recent CTLA conference it was acknowledged what a significant role our HOFFE industry plays and the significant quantity of cylinders we import into New Zealand, I therefore suggested to Worksafe that this should be reflected in the amount of correspondence we receive from them.

Worksafe also announced at the CTLA conference that they have cleared the way for foam and dry powder mobiles (23kg/lt or larger) to once again be available and be tested, I believe some new mobile units are now on their way over and some of these are pre-sold.

Inspectorate SIG Update

Commissioning of Systems

In today's modern construction environment where there is undue pressure to get a system completed, it is worthwhile remembering what is required for commissioning a system.


NZS4512:2010 Section 5 talks about the tests and checks that need to be completed to commission a new fire alarm system. There are seven areas discussed, from visual inspections to electrical checks and operational checks, to documentation requirements.

NZS4541:2013 does not have a specific section relating to the commissioning of a system. However, it does require certain things like pressure checks, underground flushing, etc. to be completed. There are also some requirements from the SSC perspective such as documentation.

So how do we get to the end of a project, request attendance by the inspector, to end up with a list of significant defects for the contractor to work through and complete? Surely if the visual checks and operational checks have been completed, the inspector should not be finding things such as Apartment Modules not working, overloaded amplifiers, or missing devices. The inspector is not there to undertake your quality control. Yes, if you get on with your inspector and ask kindly, they may offer some advice on solving the problem at hand. However, the trade-off is that the Inspector expects the Contractor to learn from their mistakes and next time resolve the problem by themselves. If the same issues continue to be identified, the question as to the competence of the Contractor starts coming to the fore.

Fire Alarm Indexes

Following on from my comments last month regarding information on fire alarm indexes, it has been brought to my attention that the Electrical Wiring Standard NZS3000:2007 Clause 2.9.2.4 requires the location of the main switchboard to be readily identifiable at each entrance used by emergency personal with an exception being "The main switchboard need not be marked at an entry to a building where the location is clearly identifiable at a Fire Indicator Panel" if not otherwise identified. This is outside of the remit of NZS4512 but may be asked for by the engineers involved with the design of the site.

Passive Fire Protection SIG Update

As always, it's a very busy time within the Passive SIG group, the coatings working group are putting the final touches to the new FPANZ code of practice for intumescent coatings, we are responding to questions surrounding the first set of passive position statements that have been circulated and are shortly to be released and in our spare time we are finalising the new NZQA level 3 passive installers qualification that will be released before year end.

In the last three years we have achieved a lot within the passive special interest group, the launch of the Passive Equipment Register, delivery of the NZQA level 3 installers qualification, a new intumescent coatings code of practice and three new passive fire position statements being released in October.

There is no doubt that the passive industry in 2019 is a much more tightly policed industry than the "olden



days", there is an expectation manufacturers and suppliers will present test data, that their data be clear and easy to understand, that the installer will need experience and someday have an industry recognised qualification, that building code compliant product is specified and installed, it's a much more stringent market than it ever used to be and quite rightly so.

Reform of Vocational Education

Kia ora, I am writing to update you further on the Government reforms which will see Workforce Development Councils (WDCs) being established and to clarify what this will mean for us as an Industry Training Organisation. We're also seeking your endorsement of potential WDC coverage and leadership of the proposed Manufacturing, Engineering and Logistics WDC.

Background

The Government intends to establish 4-7 WDCs to replace certain functions of the industry training organisations. The WDCs will cover a greater number of industry sectors than the current industry training organisations, and will deliver the following functions:



- Standard setting qualifications, unit standards, other skill standards
- Skills leadership
- Ensuring consistency of standards moderation, capstone assessment
- Advising the Tertiary Education Commission on their funding investment in providers
- Brokerage providing advice to industry.

Reform of Vocational Education cont.

WDC coverage

The Government is currently considering different approaches to the industry coverage under each WDC. Some industry sectors could align with more than one of the proposed WDCs.

Recent consultation with industry sectors that work with Competenz has indicated a strong consensus for a WDC grouping that covers skills aligned to manufacturing, engineering and logistics.

Governance

Industry sectors have told us they want to ensure that the governance and operation of the WDCs are responsive to the needs of each sector, regardless of sector size. This feedback has been acknowledged by officials from the Tertiary Education Commission (TEC) and the Ministry of Education (MOE). We'll consult further with you when the coverage is finalised, to inform you of the governance and consultation models that will be adopted in each WDC.

 Several sectors we have engaged with have indicated that they clearly see themselves in the proposed Manufacturing, Engineering and Logistics Workforce Development Council. If this applies to you, and your sector, please complete the first section of this endorsement letter. 2. Competenz believes that it has the expertise and experience to take a leadership role in establishing the proposed Manufacturing, Engineering and Logistics WDC. We would appreciate your support for this approach. Please complete the second section of the endorsement letter above to confirm your support.

Please return the completed letter to **VET@competenz.org.nz** by Friday 04 October.

Your feedback is important to ensure your sector's interests and opinions are considered as the detail of the transition is being determined. Once collated, your feedback will be presented to TEC and MOE officials.


