So far, they have not identified any units sold in New Zealand as being involved. # Fire Protection and Glazing Systems

### Introduction

The use of glass in architecture and construction is becoming increasingly pervasive in commercial buildings and industrial buildings. This presents some design, structure and risk management challenges to ensure the work is compliant and certifiable, particularly in respect of fire protection and glazing systems. Aon, as a Sprinkler System Certifier, is observing frequent design and installation issues in this regard.

Fire rated glazing is a glazing system which creates fire resistance in glass panels. Fire rated glazing is often utilised as it allows the design to incorporate a high volume of natural light and transparency, while still maximising fire safety and adhering to the fire regulations.

It is possible to provide a fire cell separation using these glazing systems. Fire rated glazing products are measured based on their fire resistance levels and their overall ability to contain a fire. Glazing systems are available to provide Fire Resistance Ratings of up -/120/120.

Unfortunately, such glazing systems are relatively expensive, which has led to an alternative, "Specific Application Window Sprinklers", being developed in conjunction with certain types of glazing.

This brief note has been prepared to give some guidance to architects and other designers to avoid Code Compliance certification delays when specifying a Window Sprinkler System.

### **Specific Application Window Sprinklers**

#### **OVERVIEW**

This alternative solution is becoming increasingly widely applied as a more cost effective option to fire rated glazing. Unfortunately Aon is seeing a number of problematic designs which simply do not comply with the Window Sprinkler installation requirements and prevent a Code Compliance Certificate being issued for the building.

Research into the use of sprinklers to provide equivalency to fire rated construction was carried out in the 1970's at CSIRO's Fire Test Laboratory in Sydney. These tests showed that to achieve satisfactory results (which will prevent the window breaking) the application of water over the glazing surface must prevent dry areas. Window sprinklers must be designed to completely wet the glazing surface, which is a function of both the location of the sprinkler and the water spray pattern developed by the sprinkler.

Presently, Aon is only aware of one approved window sprinkler and this is manufactured by Tyco. These continued next page...



This photograph illustrates a number of issues that will prevent the installation being certified

- Roller blinds have been installed between the window and sprinkler
- The two drenchers are closer than1.83m apart and not baffled by the window mullions:
- The sprinklers may be further than 305mm away from the glazing. (Not necessarily evident from photograph.)

Note: The white rectangle in the photograph is intended to prevent the standard ceiling sprinklers from wetting the window sprinklers.



This photograph illustrates a number of issues:

- The area between the two sets of doors requires an additional window sprinkler due to the vertical mullions.
- Nevertheless, the horizontal transom at the bottom of this panel precludes the use of window sprinklers to protect these central panels.
- Finally, the window sprinklers cannot be used to protect the two sets of doors.


sprinklers provide complete wetting and coverage for heat strengthened, tempered, or ceramic glass windows using closed sprinklers. Tyco's data sheet must be adhered to when using these sprinklers, as the fire rating is dependent on the window and sprinkler system (http://tyco-fire.com/TD\_TFP/TFP/20\_10\_2016. pdf).

#### **DESIGN CRITERIA**

The window sprinkler data sheet communicates the design and coordination issues for these sprinklers - architects and designers planning on using this system need to review this carefully. As with any specific application sprinkler, the installation instructions included in the data sheet must also be precisely followed.

The key design criteria include:

- The type of glazing must be a minimum of 6mm heat strengthened or tempered glazing, in a non-combustible frame fitted with EPDM rubber gasket seals.
  - This precludes wooden frames.
- The glazing must be non-operable.
  - This means that the system cannot be used to protect glazed doors or opening windows.
- The maximum height of protected glazing is 3.96m.
  - Multiple layers of window sprinklers cannot be installed to protect a taller window (or vertical sets of windows) as any wetting of the lower heads from above would directly impact on their performance.
  - There may be exceptions, to this, for example if the floor slab provides a window ledge above the second layer of sprinklers.
- The sprinklers must be able to have uninterrupted run down.
  - Horizontal mullions are not permitted.
  - If vertical mullions are spaced closer than 1.83m, they need to act as a baffle to other window sprinklers. The data sheet is very specific in dimensions required.
- If window furnishings are provided, they must be located on the opposite side to the sprinkler.
- It is not permissible to install any form of plastic film on the window as its impact on the water run-down is unknown.
- The sprinklers are required to be located below the edge of the glazing. This will either require some exposed pipe work, or some form of bulkhead to conceal the pipe.



This photograph shows droppers which ensure that the sprinklers are below the top of the glazing, (as required by Tyco's data sheet.) Unfortunately, roller blinds have been installed between the window sprinklers and glazing, precluding the ability to certify the installation.

#### **RISK MANAGEMENT CONSIDERATIONS**

Other issues that need to be considered when contemplating window sprinkler systems are risk management specific. In many cases, these sprinklers are supplied by the building's sprinkler system. It is important to consider the probability that the window sprinklers will be required to contain a fire at a time when the sprinkler system is decommissioned. Hence, the design needs to consider the level of redundancy required for the water supply. The simplest option may be to have sectional isolation valves to allow the sprinkler system protecting a floor to be isolated during tenancy fit-outs, to ensure the window sprinklers remain operational.

For example, we are aware of a high rise building in Wellington, where the window sprinkler system totally stands isolated from the sprinkler system, with a separate 200mm connection to the town's main, an electric fire pump and a 200mm riser up the building. The building's sprinkler system is fed by a 65mm riser.

The key message here is that the decision as to how the window sprinkler system is supplied is one that needs to be made by the building's design team, after considering the costs and benefits of various options. It is not a decision that can be made by the fire protection subcontractor.

### Summary

Window sprinkler systems are a viable alternative to fire rated glazing however architects and designers need to be aware of the system requirements and limitations and particularly the implications and constraints they will place on the building design.



On face value, this installation appears sound, albeit, some form of unapproved baffle plates have been fitted to both window sprinklers.


# Sprinkler Contractors Listing **Formalized Agreement**

# **Calling all Halon Fire Extinguisher Owners**

FPANZ is promoting awareness around Halon fire extinguishers and wants to recover these from the commercial sector and from private owners.

Halon has fallen out of favour due to its environmental impact and long atmospheric life time. It is considered to be a potent greenhouse gas and contributes to ozone depletion. However, safety is the main issue as servicing of Halon extinguishers has not been available since 1998 when the production of Halon was banned under the Montreal Protocol.

Over the previous ten years, more than 60 tonne of Halon has been recovered by FPANZ members and this was sent for safe destruction. It is estimated that a further five to ten tonne is still in use. This needs to be recovered now as any unit still in use will be well over ten years old and will not have been serviced.

"Fire extinguishers, just like smoke detectors, need to be checked by a certified agent annually" says Blind

"We do have fears that Halon extinguishers, due to this lack of servicing, may fail to operate correctly in the event of a fire. We are prompting all members of the public to check their boats, cars, workshops, caravans and planes to see if they still have a yellow Halon extinguisher and to exchange this for a unit coloured red". "There will be a cost to change, however both the public and the environment will benefit as we can be sure new systems will operate correctly in event of a fire and the impact on the ozone layer will also be reduced" says Blind.



There are now many suitable and cleaner alternatives available and FPANZ members located nationwide will accept Halon units and provide information on the safer alternatives available. Halon extinguishers are easy to identify as they are bright yellow. Replacement units will be coloured red.

"We look forward to gathering as many of the remaining Halon systems and hand held fire extinguishers here in New Zealand and to have the contents safely destroyed" says Blind.

"We will also have greater confidence that owners will be protected in the event of a fire and this will ultimately protect lives".

Our message is: "Be Safe Yellow is Out - Red is In!"

# Yellow extinguishers, Halon extinguishers, are so old – if you have one, the chances are they will let you or your family down in a fire.

Halon damages the ozone layer which in turn can affect our health, causing skin cancer, cataracts and other illness as well. Damaging the ozone layer can also impact on our weather, our soil and our crops.

Protect yourself, your family or business, by handing in your old yellow extinguisher. It's easy to do – simply take it to the nearest local approved Fire Extinguisher Service Agent. A list can be found at www.fireprotection.org.nz



While there, talk to these experts about your needs and how best to protect against fire, including alternatives such as a red fire extinguisher\*, a fire blanket, a smoke alarm, and other effective choices. Often a combination is the best approach.

**So act now and hand in your old yellow extinguisher.** It's a service for the general public and small businesses. A small recovery charge will be set at \$10 per kilogram (up to a maximum extinguisher weight of 2.1 kg in size). A Halon extinguisher larger than 2.1kg is considered a commercial size and will be disposed of at a quoted rate.

\*There is more than one type of red fire extinguisher on the market. Ask which one best suits your needs.
