Welcome to the May edition of the newsletter

Membership Year 2018-2019

This has been called for by the wider membership to ensure all members are aware of their obligations and are playing by the rules.

We are also embarking on the process of updating our database and the information we have about our members. Changes in staff numbers will affect your membership tier level, so please notify us ASAP so we can make the necessary corrections before producing the membership certificates. Passive Equipment Register Launch Event

Charitable Trust

Many of you know we have been working on forming a trust separate from FPANZ for standards development and training. As you read this, the formation of the charitable trust is underway. I am very pleased to announce that the deed has been written and approved by the board, and we are now in the final process of trustee appointment and filing paperwork to activate the trust. I will continue to provide updates on this process as it nears completion. It is another significant project and objective complete for this year.

Fire101

I am also exceptionally proud to announce that we are in the final stages of the process with MIT to be able to run the pilot Fire101 course. Starting in July or August, subject to final sign off, this will be another significant project promised and delivered by the association. I would like to acknowledge the hard work of the training SIG and Trent for getting this project on track. As a group,

CHARTER UPDATE

Evacuation Consultants SIG Update Author **Phil Jackson** - Evacuation Consultants SIG Chair

With a little under two month until the revised regulations are released we are receiving an increased number of queries with regard to what these may look like, we expect to hear more at the next SIG meeting.

The Evacuation Consultant steering group has put together a training matrix spanning the range of competencies we are expected to possess. As this develops it is timely that we are writing guidelines describing when and how an evacuation consultant should be engaged into a project.

This month has seen some interesting questions arise; the first was a consultant asking the best practice during trial evacuations when dealing with animals in an office environment, what are your experiences? The second was a query regarding two buildings - both under the same consent, same use, same fire alarm system, and same owner. I was asked why they would need two schemes.

In early May I was invited to observe a ward evacuation exercise at Auckland DHB, there was plenty of realism within the exercise including participants playing the role of patients and visitors in various states of health, attitude

and ability. With a good smoke machine, and a well briefed fire technician behind the scenes the nursing team were kept on their toes. There is also the added value of Massey University providing a technical analysis of the event, I



hope to see the team at the next SIG meeting. Well done to all involved, I look forward to seeing more scenario based evacuation drills.

For those of you that use the FENZ online portal keep an eye on their website as they will be updating the documents in the Online Services website as part of the rebranding of all resources.

As usual I look forward to hearing from you with the various topics that arise, our next meeting is on the 11th June, at the Royal New Zealand Yacht Club. You're welcome in person or via skype conferencing.

There seems to be an ever-increasing number of websites that are linking to each other, while this is certainly not a new thing it means information has become even more accessible. I was recently going through the Worksafe site & noticed the link to the Fire & Emergency (FENZ) site which includes a helpful guide for both home & business fire protection. Also pleasing was to see that the site encourages people to use NZS4503:2005 as the standard to reference for advice on Hand Operated Fire Fighting Equipment (HOFFE). While the 2005 edition of NZS4503 has parts that need attention, such as the always controversial phrase "Competent Person", in the main the consensus seems to be that it is still a sound document, that could maybe do with a few amendments.



We look forward to having Todd O'Donoghue from FENZ at our June HOFFE group meeting to enlighten us on the implications of the revision of the Fire Safety & Evacuation Regulations & how they may impact on us all. Those of you who cannot attend in person may wish to utilize the conference option now available through the FPA.


