#### **CATE Conference** and Industry Profile

While we were disappointed in the delays in our Fire101 pilot project this year, several initiatives are still underway that link in with attracting school leavers to our industry and, in the future, to the pathway we are

creating. One such initiative

has been our work with careers advisors to raise our profile at the school level and make them aware that many of our members have positions available.

The Careers & Transition Education Association Aotearoa (CATE) held their annual conference in Auckland this month. Together with the Institute of Fire Engineers (IFE) and Society of Fire Protection Engineers (SFPE), we saw this as an excellent opportunity to raise our profile with careers advisors and made the most of this event to increase the visibility of our industry and the career options within it. With close to 800 careers advisors attending, this was time and effort well spent.

We have produced several flyers, folders, banners and other marketing material to help us get our message across to schools, students, parents and the like. We are also working on attending future careers events to

further drive the message that the fire protection industry is a viable alternative to other better-known trades. Our objective is to have school leavers contacting us from all around NZ to find out about the available positions; we then aim to hold events at which members and school leavers can meet and discuss positions and/or work experience to attract youth to the industry.

We are also working on projects to raise the industry profile with other similar trades in an effort to demonstrate how easy it can be for some to switch to a career within the fire protection industry. As with the training project, these are not projects that can be completed quickly, but they are important and the benefits will soon come. This is the first time the association has put so much effort into these areas, and we are confident it is worth doing.

#### **Passive Installers Level 3 Qualification**

We are pleased with the progress being made toward a new qualification for installers of passive fire protection systems, which our SIG has been calling for. We will likely see its formation in early 2019. Once in place, we will also be encouraging our members to enrol staff, with our aim being for all FPANZ members to have their staff qualified in a workable timeframe. We also feel that some sort of licensing of parts of the fire protection industry—not just passive but also sprinklers, alarms, etc.—is well worth pursuing. This has support in several sectors now, including the Insurance Council of NZ, and we will continue our efforts with the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment (MBIE) on this topic.

However, in lieu of this and while it is being set up, we collectively need to push towards higher standards of self-regulation and workmanship ourselves.

Again this month I am pleased to welcome the following new members to our growing organisation.

### Training SIG Update - Author Trent Fearnley - Training SIG Chair

The training SIG met on 23 October for a workshop with MIT. The purpose of this workshop was to discuss the assessment criteria for each of the new fire papers for the Diploma of Fire Engineering. There was a good turnout of about 15 people to cover all aspects of the papers. We discussed the pre-requisite requirements, assessing methods (assignments / tests / practical assessments) for each paper. Following that we discussed the assessment methodology for those in the industry wanting to gain recognition for prior learning for the course. This workshop was very productive and I thank all those people who attended.

Scott Lawson, Michael James and myself lead a group of members to attend the Careers and Transition Education Association (CATE) conference where we had a stand to promote the Fire Safety Industry as a career option for students. This conference was attended by around 800 careers advisors from all over the country. I also presented to a workshop session there on our new pathway. Both were well received and many if not all did not even consider any jobs outside of firefighting in the fire safety industry. Many thought that sprinkler technicians were a branch of plumbing, likewise fire alarm technicians were just normal electricians. They did not know we are a specialist field in our own right. So from that perspective we had a lot of engagement and we had a lot of interest in our Gateway programme. A very worthwhile event and a good way to promote our industry.



As you are aware MIT failed to

deliver our Gateway programme. As a result of the above conference we have 3 other parties interested in working with us to deliver the programme. Scott will be leading the discussion with the parties to get the programme across the line. Comments from the advisers/ teachers/schools is that 2 week holiday programme is more feasible for them. We will now be working on this timeframe for the programme. We will hope to engage the services of one of these parties prior to Christmas to get the programme content developed and then to promote it.

Lastly I would once again like to thank the members of the SIG group for their efforts and also to those others that helped out on the stand at the CATE conference.

## **Evacuation Consultants SIG Update**

As the year draws to a close, I want to thank those that have taken time to attend the meetings, and FENZ workshops and helped to shape the way that the regulations are interpreted.

Now is a good time to be reminded that the new signage requirements for fire action notices come into place on the 1st January 2019, in many cases schemes being processed now will require the new signage to meet the regulations. It is also worth noting that some changes have been made to the regulations which will come into effect from 18th December, these primarily clarify the extent of a tenants responsibility to maintain means of escape, and new offences which are covered under the Fire and Emergency New Zealand (Offences) Regulations 2018. With these Regulations now in place, FENZ are commencing the work to establish how they will operationalise them during 2019.

from 21st December 2018 – 7th January 2019

## HOFFE SIG Update - Author Steve Smith - HOFFE SIG Chair

Well Christmas is just around the corner, that said I am not sure how much good will is on offer from certain sectors. We continue to hear of contractors who are being left unpaid by the companies they subcontract to and many of us are having to chase harder to get paid. At least some sort of break over Christmas is guaranteed even if it is only the stat days!!!

We had our usual meeting on the 5th November and welcomed Brendon from Flamestop to our fold for his first meeting. It was a good meeting with plenty of input on a variety of topics, including various aspects of training.

Training can be an interesting topic, discussed during the meeting was an example where inexperienced and untrained people in wholesale outlets make recommendations to the public on what equipment they require, we believe this could be a potentially dangerous situation. We also see companies that will offer a variety of other services and will carry out your fire extinguisher certifying. At the same time add to that the person who is deemed "competent" but has little to no experience with fire extinguishers. One of the many dangers here is they have little to no backup or support from the fire equipment industry, they are not familiar with the range of products or variant's in the market place, mistakes can easily happen. Training in the use of fire equipment is another important part of the industry and certainly an area of growing importance in every sense. We have seen many innovations in this area including training trailers, interactive simulators and now virtual reality



units. The reality is that while live fire is the best and most realistic way to train, in many situations the most practical may be a to simulate a fire. Some development is currently underway through the universities to develop a virtual reality version that suits our requirements.

At the end of the day Hand Operated Fire Fighting Equipment is the most often used effective means of extinguishing a fire and saving both people and millions of dollars worth of property and plant each year. Therefore, knowing both the capabilities and limitations of the fire extinguishers before you need to use them is important, especially as no one type of fire extinguisher is suited to all classes of fire.

I believe training and educating will continue to be growth areas for our industry especially as people become more aware of health and safety requirements.

## Passive Fire Protection SIG Update

Following November's SIG meeting, we held our first protective coatings working group meeting which went very well, the group has much work ahead of it. The next step is to review a number of International technical guides to see how they might help form the basis of our New Zealand document. We will discuss further at our December meeting and report back!

NZQA level 3 – "Passive Installers Qualification" is ongoing. This should change gear in January with the hope of delivering in June 2019.

The passive industry is going through huge change – for the better in most cases – although we do feel we need to produce documentation at some stage to help define "roles and responsibilities" within the passive compliance process.

Many are unsure of their part in the compliance pathway and many let power go to their head and step well beyond their part

in the process. We will be working on guidance to help map out where one parties responsibilities starts and where another steps in.

The way forward should not be about egos or commercial gain – it's about improving life safety!

## Inspectorate SIG Update

Wow another year nearly done, where does the time go?

I thought I would start this month's newsletter with some positive news. Anecdotal evidence is showing our message about lifting the standard of install is getting out; and inspection staff I have spoken to have noticed a real increase in the overall standard of work that they are inspecting since the series of FPA Get It Right seminars earlier this year.

We have however come across one issue of concern recently with the overloading of amplifiers, causing them to cut out. This has been traced back to a number of issues such as:

- Not doing a design calculation of number of speakers, potential tappings and required Amp size.
- Over tapping of speakers, installers leaving the speakers set at factory settings.
- Faulty speakers and windings.
- No commissioning checks being done.
- Actual impedance vs theoretical impedance.

The first two items should be easily addressed with a little thought put into the design and enough spare capacity being allowed for changes on site if necessary. If the correct commissioning tests are being carried out before the inspector gets to site, then none of the above should be an issue. However, this is often not the case and most inspectors are now carrying impedance meters to check the loading of the speaker circuits.

# Actual impedance vs theoretical impedance.



As an installer recently found out to their detriment the actual impedance reading of a speaker may not match the theoretical value, e.g. a site that during the design calculation had come in at 75% of the amplifiers rated output when tested was actually 110% of the power rating, after some investigation it was discovered that the speakers used had actual impedance readings 30% higher than what the tapping showed i.e., a .33 watt tapping was actually .4 watts and the .66 approximately .85 of a watt.

Please remember the Inspectors are there to sample check and confirm compliance as per the standards, they are not there to perform your commissioning tests nor to be quality control for your installations.

Looking forward to another great year for the industry into 2019.
