FireNZ

What a great conference we had, once again. The event seems to go from strength to strength, and although we were down a little on stand numbers this year, this is not uncommon when the conference is outside of the main centres because of the additional logistics for exhibitors. However, the delegate numbers were close to those in Auckland in 2017, and the feedback on the surveys we sent to exhibitors, delegates and speakers has been overwhelmingly positive. We value the input and that people take the time to complete the surveys as this helps us fine tune the event each year.

This year, we were fortunate to have an outstanding selection of international speakers to complement our solid line-up of local talent. It was also great to have presentations from young members of the Society of Fire Protection Engineers (SFPE). The development of new local talent is important for our industry and FireNZ gives these members a great opportunity to learn from more seasoned speakers. We have received overwhelmingly positive feedback on each of the five international keynote speakers, and I would like to personally thank Niall Rowan, Arnold Dix, Sean Decrane, Dr David Crowder and Jonathan Barnett for taking the time to come and present to us in New Zealand. It's not easy to get this calibre of speaker to come such long distances to present, let alone coordinate five of them from four different parts of the globe.

AGM and Special Resolution

With the completion of our financial year and the audit, the next step is to report to members on our results for the last financial year. To this end, we are preparing our annual report, which will be presented to members at the AGM at 4pm on 28 November at the Royal New Zealand Yacht Squadron.

This year's AGM is even more important than usual, as we are tabling a special resolution to amend the association's constitution so it can keep pace with changes to regulations for not-for-profit organisations and for other general housekeeping reasons. All the relevant documents have been sent to the nominated contact for each member company. Please ensure you have your say – if you will not be attending the AGM, please send in the proxy voting form so your vote still counts.

Fire101 and Careers Update

I am disappointed to advise that we have not been able to get Manukau Institute of Technology (MIT) to commit the necessary resources to deliver Fire101. As many of you will know, the polytechnic sector in general has been struggling, and significant restructuring has taken place within MIT. This has caused unwelcome delays in contract negotiations and agreed timeframes slipping

twice. As a result, we are now working with two other providers to get the project back on track.

While we are disappointed to have lost the best part of a year on this, I am confident we will deliver this pilot and formulate an ongoing pathway to bring school leavers into our industry. The whole process has been a learning experience for all of us involved and highlights that the development of such bold initiatives will often take longer than expected.

While we progress with our primary objectives, we are also working on other supplementary objectives such as raising our industry profile with careers advisors. To this end, we will be displaying at the three-day National Careers and Transition Education Association (CATE) conference in November, which will expose over 600 careers advisors from around New Zealand to our industry and is a great way to raise our profile. It will be the first time we have actively branded our industry to these advisors.

Its going to demand a lot of time and effort and the key members of industry are involved and making sure it happens. We all know the rewards to the industry will be worth it! As always, we have many other initiatives we are working on behind the scenes but with all of us devoting free time to improving our industry, we have to prioritise and focus our efforts in one direction at a time!

EPS Buildings Author Chris Mak - Manager - Aon Fire Protection

Insurance markets regularly cycle between hard and soft markets. We are currently in a hard market.

This means that the insurance companies are carefully reviewing their risks and carefully considering how much cover they will place and on what terms.

There have been some recent substantial fire losses with EPS buildings in Australia, including a loss in excess of \$A60m, in a Queensland bacon factory, in 2016 and a \$A400m loss, in a South Australian abattoir, this year.

This experience is now impacting on New Zealand and insurers are increasing the cost of premiums, the value of the deductibles and reducing the amount of cover that they will place on EPS buildings. Several insurers simply will not underwrite EPS risks (whether sprinkler protected or not) but may write PIR. Other insurers have communicated that the only form of protection they will consider acceptable for EPS exposed risks is for there to be a fully code compliant sprinkler system including the initial inspection, and the biennial re-inspection being current and all defects remedied.

Buildings constructed with PIR, while not required to be sprinkler protected, may also be subject to restrictions in capacity from insurers.

Those advising on the design and construction of insulated buildings need to take cognisance of this and ensure that their clients are well informed of the construction implications on the insurability of these types of buildings.



Fire Protection Charitable Trust Established

I'm pleased to report that the inaugural meeting of the newly-established Fire Protection Charitable Trust was held in Auckland on 3rd October.

The Trust is an independent, neutral, charitable entity with two core purposes:

- a) Ongoing development of fire safety standards, and
- b) Training, qualifications and professional development of people working in the fire protection industry.

The Trust will receive levies (via Aon) from new sprinkler Installations and (via Accredited Inspection Bodies) from fire alarm system inspections. Levies will also be collected from fire alarm manufacturers.

This money will be used to fund the fire protection industry share of revision costs for the respective Fixed Fire Protection and Fire Detection and Alarm standards. The current revision of NZS 4541 and the scheduled revision of NZS 4512 being the initial priorities. In future, it is hoped that the Trust might become a vehicle to receive and distribute funds related to training and standards in other disciplines: Hand-Operated Fire Fighting, Passive Fire Protection, and possibly even government training and qualification development grants. All Trust funds will be held and accounted for independently of any other industry body.

Formal Charities Commission registration has been applied for. The initial Trustees are: David Prosser (Chairperson), Chris Mak (Interim Treasurer), Nicky Marshall (Secretary), and Mitchell Brown. Appointment of a fifth Trustee is in progress.

The Trustees are particularly grateful to FPANZ for having the vision to establish the Trust, and for their practical assistance with administration.

Meeting with Ministers Twyford and Salesa

We have continued with our meetings with officials, MP's and Ministers.

This week I have met with John Ivil, MBIE official in charge of Govt. Procurement; Andrew Bayley and Paul Goldsmith of National, and last night Greg and I met with Ministers Twyford and Salesa, accompanied by Anna Butler who I have a sound relationship with, and other officials.

The meetings have all gone well and the message has got through that government need to engage with NZSTCF on behalf of Specialist Trades and the sector. The meeting with Twyford and Salesa was particularly positive, they had a strong interest in developments from Ebert and Orange H, as well as in our views on changes needed in the sector. Hayley from Acumen Republic has supported us with these meetings and will write follow up letters to all.

I have also been talking with the receiver for Eberts and will be assisting where we can with resolving issues around interpretation of the CCA. I will have an update on progress in the next few days.
