

### Passive Fire Protection SIG Update

The SIG meeting took place on Monday 12th February, the meeting was well attended (as usual), we had number of members calling in from different NZ regions as well as overseas – a good indication the net is widening, and that positive change is happening – members are keen to be a part of the good work taking place within the SIG!

The FPANZ Passive Register is ready for launch – a number of key supplier members have submitted products for inclusion – the register will go live on the FPANZ web site ([www.fireprotection.org.nz](http://www.fireprotection.org.nz)) in March – this is the first Association led – online - passive fire protection material register of its kind Globally – a full range of NZ Code Compliant products which industry can access.

The register has many uses however one of the major problems industry has had to date is when an older building is being refurbished and ANARP (as near as reasonably practical) solutions are permitted for use – but only when there is no other AS 1530.4-2005 / AS 4072.1 – 2005 NZ Code compliant product available – pre FPANZ Passive Register – industry had to spend days if not weeks chasing around suppliers and manufacturers trying to find out if there was a solution available before they could consider ANARP – now – a quick reference to the online passive register will save time and money and ensure the correct product is being installed – thus raising the compliance bar and ensuring we leave buildings in a much safer state than previously!

The two other areas the SIG is focussed on is Training and Position Statements.

Training is well in hand – Competenz gave a short presentation at the meeting and there is a commitment from them to work with members of the Passive Fire SIG to introduce an NZQA level 3 and 4 qualifications focussed on installation and design – the lack of a meaningful training qualification has been one of the main reasons for poor passive fire protection to date and will be a huge step forward when launched.

The third target for the SIG is “position statements” – industry is well aware passive fire protection has been under the spot light for a number of years - with the “doom and gloom” has brought a rise in the number of self-proclaimed “passive experts” – who readily deliver advice and commentary which is not always in line with industry thinking – with the up and coming FPANZ passive fire protection position statements – this will help provide guidance based on the voice of industry – not individuals!

With the Passive Register, Passive Fire Installation & design qualification and position statements all coming together during 2018 – this year could see the most advancement our industry has ever experienced – and I would like to thank members for the continued support.

## Training SIG Update

I hope you have all had a great break over the Christmas period and are refreshed and rearing to go. The Training SIG has been busy whilst you have been on holiday and I am pleased to announce that our Fire 101 course now "Certificate of Achievement in Fire Technology" has been approved by NZQA and has been awarded full funding. We are now planning the first course for the 7 May. This will be held at Manukau Institute of Technology, Auckland. We are working on finalising some of the site visits with the help of FPA members. As previously mentioned we will be running the first course for 30 students over a 5 week period. Scott will be sending a flyer out on this shortly for you to distribute amongst your networks.

If you are wondering what you can do to help this initiative then we have an answer for you. On completion of this course we are looking to find employment for these 30 students. If you are looking to employ someone shortly could you please let Scott know so that we can build a list of vacancies for them. We would appreciate your support for this initiative.

We have also been busy on the Diploma of Fire Engineering. I recently presented at the NZDE/ BEngTech Joint Tutors Forum which was attend by the NZ Board of Engineering Diplomas and many Polytechnics from around the country. Once again our diploma received a lot of support and I managed to speak with the board members about progressing it further. Subsequently we now have to formally present it to the Board at their Quality Assurance meeting, then to NZQA. We are still on track to have it ready for the mid-year semester start.

Once we have the diploma approved and ready to go we will be working on the next phase which is micro-credentialing. This is a combination of recognition of prior learning and competency based assessment. By using this method it will hopefully reduce the time to complete the course for those already in employment with some of the skills and experience needed to meet the criteria. So watch this space for more of an update.

### Quick Update.

With our first inspectorate SIG meeting for this year now under our belt 2018 looks to be a good one for all involved, as a lot of the industry will now be aware Fire Protection Inspection Services is no longer, FPIS was an institution within the fire protection industry and certainly helped ensure that our industry has an excellent record of installations done to high standard. A big Thankyou To All those involved over the years.

While FPIS may now no longer be around the inspectorate industry is still thriving all be it with a different mix of inspectors amongst the existing company's, I would also like to welcome the industries latest inspectorate to the mix, Sprinkler & Alarm Inspections Ltd (SAIL) based out of Christchurch, A full list of Sprinkler and Alarm Inspectorates can be found on the FPA website.

During our SIG meeting a vote was held with regards to supporting the FPA proposal for a levy on inspections

of new and altered Fire Alarm systems as a method of funding future revisions of the NZS4512 Fire Alarm standard, this came back with a majority vote 5/6 for and we have sent a letter of support through to the FPA. The final details for this are to be worked out at board level and once agreed upon the wider industry will be given opportunity to comment.

We are also working on a format for an Alarm technical committee to provide some industry guidance on design and installation practices in the form of either Technical notices or design guides, we are currently working through format and legal issues with this and I hope to be able to give more details soon.

## FI-131 clarifies Remote Signaling requirements for Networked Fire Alarm Systems

Formal Interpretation FI-131 has clarified the requirements for remote signalling (brigade connection) of networked fire alarm systems.

NZS 4512 clause 401.1 defines the limits of a “sector” (the area permitted to be covered by a single control unit). Networked systems, however, can have multiple control units within the permissible sector area. It is also possible for a multi-panel network to encompass several sectors.

FI-131 clarifies that one remote connection only is required per sector. Each sector also requires at least one indicating unit where all alarm conditions from that sector can be viewed and controlled: one of these would be the designated fire service attendance point for that sector. A combined multi-sector indicating unit is also permitted.

As always, Fire and Emergency NZ approval is required for control and indicating unit layouts and locations (clauses 402.8.2, 403.1.1, and 403.2), so it pays to involve them early in the design process.

NZS 4512:2010 *Fire Detection and Alarm Systems in Buildings* – Appendix A and clause 401.1

#### Question:

Signalling to a remote receiving centre by networked fire control units -

Where transmission of an alarm to summon Fire & Emergency NZ assistance is a declared functional requirement of the fire alarm system, Appendix A3 requires each control unit to be connected to a remote receiving centre and separately identifiable by the fire service alarm transport system.

Clause 401.1 sets conditions and limitations on the floor area and number of buildings on a site that can be covered by a single control unit (or sector, per the definition of 104).

- a) In cases where the clause 401.1 limitations on floor area or multiple buildings are not exceeded:
- 1) May multiple control units, each covering part of the sector, be optionally networked together?
  - 2) If signalling to a remote receiving centre is a declared functional requirement for such a system, must every additional networked control unit contained within the same sector be connected to and separately identifiable at the remote receiving centre?
  - 3) May all the zone indications for the networked system be combined in one indicating unit?

#### Interpretation issued by the Alarms and detection group:

- a) In such cases, all zones and control units are contained within a single sector.
- 1) Yes, this is permitted provided all alarm conditions can be viewed and controlled from a single location.
  - 2) No, a single remote connection per sector is acceptable.
  - 3) Yes, in fact all zone indications must appear on every indicating unit.

# FI-133 clarifies spacing for Line-Type heat and smoke detectors around ceiling protrusions

Formal Interpretation FI-133 has clarified the requirements for spacing of line-type heat and smoke detectors around ceiling protrusions (beams, joists, purlins etc.).

Essentially the 2/3rds spacing rule applies when the linear heat detector line or smoke beam runs parallel to the protrusions, but not where it runs at right angles to the protrusions.

NZS 4512:2010 *Fire Detection and Alarm Systems in Buildings* – Clause 405.3.2 Spacing for Line Type Heat Detectors

### Question:

Clause 405.3.2 (a) requires line-type heat detectors to be spaced in accordance with the conditions of clause 405.2 as far as they are applicable and appropriate.

Do the sections of clause 405.2.1 requiring detector spacing to be reduced to two-thirds in the presence of protrusions (beams, joists, purlins etc.) apply to line-type heat detectors?

### Interpretation issued by the Alarms and detection group:

Yes.

Where the line-type heat detector is run parallel to the protrusions, line spacing of not more than two-thirds of the 8 m specified in clause 405.3.2 (b) is required.

Where the line-type heat detector is run at right angles to the protrusions, 8 m line spacing is acceptable.

### NOTE:

The same principles also apply to beam-type smoke detector spacing per clause 405.3.4.




## Not the usual call-out for Fire and Emergency NZ

## "GET IT RIGHT" Seminar Series Sprinkler Systems

This seminar series is driven by the ongoing changes we face as an industry and the importance of selecting the right products to meet design and standards requirements.

FPANZ is running a series of full-day workshops throughout the country to continue its plan of education and information to ensure the industry is continuing to get the latest information and support.

### EARTHQUAKES

Following recent earthquake events in NZ (Christchurch, Wellington and Kaikoura,) it appears that the rest of the building industry have awoken, and are now designing to protect the building and occupants against earthquake damage. While as a generalisation, sprinkler systems have performed admirably in these events, there has been some criticism of how we are designing and installing our seismic bracing systems. The playing field has changed and the construction industry are asking for more of the fire trades.

The presenters will outline what is now going to be expected, to ensure that systems will meet expectations and be able to be certified.

### PIPE INSTALLATION PRACTICES

As we roll out these training seminars over the next few years, we will be inviting specialist subject matter experts to educate industry. Mitch Buckley will be our first presenter, talking about correct grooving practises. In NZ, our industry training on roll grooving has been handed down by generations of sprinkler fitters over the past 40 odd years. It has become evident that some of the practises are flawed, which has resulted in a number of catastrophic pipe failures over the years.

### STANDARDS DEVELOPMENT

It is hoped that MBIE/SNZ will approve a work program to update NZS4541. The possible future direction of NZS4541 will be outlined, and your opinion on what is wrong and what needs to be fixed will be discussed, We will ensure that you know how to get your viewpoint across. We'll also very briefly touch on NZS4512.
