Welcome to the newsletter for July.

With the recent tragedy at the Grenfell Tower apartment building, the response has been both disappointing and encouraging. The disappointment lies in the extent to which some organisations and individuals are milking it purely for their own benefit. However, it is encouraging that so many

organisations are using it to look harder locally to ensure the same does not happen here.

We do need to wait for the full findings around this tragedy, but enough information is coming out to give us key areas on which to focus.

I hear many people discussing the building cladding systems used and the effects of those. My personal view is that our expertise is in fire protection, so our comments should be based purely around that area.

Our association includes several areas of specialisation, so we also need to be mindful that fire protection should be viewed holistically. Consider the following special interest groups (SIGs):

- Sprinkler & Fire Alarms Contractors,
- Passive Fire Protection,
- Hand-Operated Fire-Fighting Equipment, and
- Evacuation Consultants.

This seems to be something that isn't always considered when people talk about fire protection. As we each have our own area of expertise, it is sometimes easy to forget that fire protection involves more than that.

In New Zealand, it is more likely than not that many buildings will have multiple systems, including passive protection systems, active systems such as sprinkler systems and fire alarms, fire extinguishers, and evacuation schemes. It is the view of FPANZ that all these systems play a part in total occupant safety and provide added levels of redundancy.

The public and media are showing intense interest in fire protection since the Grenfell Tower disaster. Clearly, we need to identify where there is room to improve standards and safety, but—more importantly—we actually need to provide solutions. To this end, the purpose of and outcomes from the SIGs are more critical than ever, and I encourage you to be part of these. You will see in the monthly SIG updates that we as an association have a lot going on and are working on some exciting projects.

Membership Renewal

Over the past few weeks, I have been trying to catch up with as many members as I can. With the start of a new membership year, I have tried to get to anyone I have not bumped into or spoken with over the year and am yet to connect with some of you. I have found the experience really rewarding to say the least, and it has been great to hear so many positive comments about the changes and progress the industry is making.

We still have much to do, but it's heartening that progress is being noticed. It is also great that many of you are getting the newsletter because, as I am sure you are aware, it's the most effective method for us to communicate with the entire membership en masse.

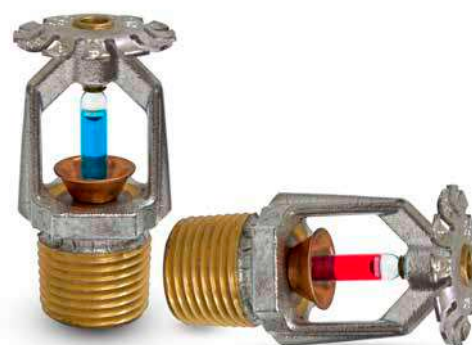

The Fire Extinguisher Product Register is for suppliers & as such is referenced by the FPA Code Of Practice for suppliers of HOFFE. As a step to ensure that a good level of quality is maintained the criteria for this initiative is designed to ensure that only compliant products from ethical member companies will be listed.

Passive Fire Protection SIG Update

How Hard Can It Be!

This month's article outlines how a passive fire protection code compliant building should be designed, planned and executed and who should play what part in the process.

Its not complicated – it just needs extra time spent at the design stage and some supervisory time during the build to make a project run smooth!

The process is this -

- **Design – the crucial part of the process - it's the key to any code compliant passive fire installation.**

The architect normally commissions a fire engineer to prepare a fire design for the property – one of the end results is a marked-up drawing showing the fire rating of each fire compartment separation.

The architect over lays the building services drawings showing which penetration pass through which fire separation.

- The next stage in the process is **consultation** with a specialist passive fire protection product manufacturer / supplier to help specify the products best suited to which penetrations. This might sound like a quick process – but there are many considerations – for example – cables – how big, how many, what size opening should be formed and if there is suitable AS 4072.1/AS 1530.4 test data supporting the design.

In many cases – the manufacturer/supplier will prepare a specific system drawing which is placed in the architectural drawings package for consent, pricing, construction monitoring and council sign off upon completion.

- (1) Consent – council examines the submission – checks the passive fire design on the FPANZ passive product register and if compliant – consent is provided.
- (2) Tender – the main contractor knows what they are pricing as the system is clearly designed – no confusion or guessing games!
- (3) Construction – the builder knows exactly what size openings are needed and what services should pass through to be compliant to the tested system.
- (4) Passive installation – the specialist installer knows exactly what firestop system are to be priced and installed
- (5) Construction monitoring – the monitor knows what they are monitoring – the system is clearly detailed – they don't need to question what has been consented!

- (6) Sign off – the contractor knows what they are paying for, council know exactly what they are signing off.
- (7) IQP – Twelve months on – the IQP knows exactly what system has been installed – its on the original design document and compliance register.

What we currently have in the market place is very different – lack of design at early stages, no idea what products are being priced or installed, no idea of the size of openings, number of services, councils providing consents assuming all products are AS 4072.1 code compliant, passive fire installers and manufacturers not having tested systems available for the openings that have been unwittingly formed and filled – the list goes on and the cost goes up!

If industry spent just a bit more time at the early stage of the design – passive fire protection would become a whole lot easier and the level of life safety would be raised!

Calling all Halon Fire Extinguisher Owners



FPANZ is promoting awareness around Halon fire extinguishers and wants to recover these from the commercial sector and from private owners.

Halon has fallen out of favour due to its environmental impact and long atmospheric life time. It is considered to be a potent greenhouse gas and contributes to ozone depletion. However, safety is the main issue as servicing of Halon extinguishers has not been available since 1998 when the production of Halon was banned under the Montreal Protocol.

Over the previous ten years, more than 60 tonne of Halon has been recovered by FPANZ members and this was sent for safe destruction. It is estimated that a further five to ten tonne is still in use. This needs to be recovered now as any unit still in use will be well over ten years old and will not have been serviced.

“Fire extinguishers, just like smoke detectors, need to be checked by a certified agent annually” says Blind

“We do have fears that Halon extinguishers, due to this lack of servicing, may fail to operate correctly in the event of a fire. We are prompting all members of the public to check their boats, cars, workshops, caravans and planes to see if they still have a yellow Halon extinguisher and to exchange this for a unit coloured red”.

“There will be a cost to change, however both the public and the environment will benefit as we can be sure new systems will operate correctly in event of a fire and the impact on the ozone layer will also be reduced” says Blind.

There are now many suitable and cleaner alternatives available and FPANZ members located nationwide will accept Halon units and provide information on the safer alternatives available. Halon extinguishers are easy to identify as they are bright yellow. Replacement units will be coloured red.

“We look forward to gathering as many of the remaining Halon systems and hand held fire extinguishers here in New Zealand and to have the contents safely destroyed” says Blind.

“We will also have greater confidence that owners will be protected in the event of a fire and this will ultimately protect lives”.

Our message is: **“Be Safe Yellow is Out – Red is In!”**

Yellow extinguishers, Halon extinguishers, are so old – if you have one, the chances are they will let you or your family down in a fire.

Halon damages the ozone layer which in turn can affect our health, causing skin cancer, cataracts and other illness as well. Damaging the ozone layer can also impact on our weather, our soil and our crops.

Protect yourself, your family or business, by handing in your old yellow extinguisher. It's easy to do – simply take it to the nearest local approved Fire Extinguisher Service Agent. A list can be found at www.fireprotection.org.nz

While there, talk to these experts about your needs and how best to protect against fire, including alternatives such as a red fire extinguisher*, a fire blanket, a smoke alarm, and other effective choices. Often a combination is the best approach.

So act now and hand in your old yellow extinguisher. It's a service for the general public and small businesses. A small recovery charge will be set at \$10 per kilogram (up to a maximum extinguisher weight of 2.1 kg in size). A Halon extinguisher larger than 2.1kg is considered a commercial size and will be disposed of at a quoted rate.

**There is more than one type of red fire extinguisher on the market. Ask which one best suits your needs.*
