The topic for the next sessions is gas flooding systems, which will be a more in-depth full-day session. As this is a very specific topic and audience numbers are likely to be limited, the seminars will only be held in Auckland, Wellington and Christchurch and are subject to enough enrolments.

We will send out a schedule for these members' meetings just as soon as we can confirm arrangements and as rules around gatherings permit.

RENEWAL OF MEMBERSHIP FOR 2020–2021 FY

Our financial year finishes at the end of June 2020, and with that, the new membership year will start. Over the next few weeks, FPANZ representatives will phone as many members as possible to touch base and hear about the impact of lockdown and other related flowon effects on our members' daily operations. This will help us adjust our focus and direction to areas of most importance to our members.

We have already begun this process, and it is clear that some of our previous plans, including the industry awareness and school leaver recruitment position, need to be put on hold and reassessed so they best fit the post-COVID-19 environment we now face. Feedback from members will be essential as we

modify our plans for the next financial year to best support our members.

MEMBERSHIP APPLICATIONS

During lockdown, we temporarily suspended the processing of all new memberships. While we operated remotely and dealt with the significantly increased workload to ensure we met the needs of our members, we felt our focus should be on supporting current financial members and their immediate priorities. We are ensuring that we are working on and advocating in relation to minor work consents, qualifications, vocational education and training, fire industry standards, codes of practice, industry position statements and government subsidies relief for industries, to name just a few. We lobby on behalf of industry to free our members up to get on with their daily operations knowing there is a strong body advocating on their behalf.

QUALITY MUST REMAIN OUR PRIORITY

In the past fortnight we have kickstarted our Fire & Smoke Stopping Code of Practice working group which is a really a positive initiative that the Passive SIG will develop and deliver for industry. We have collaboration from inside the SIG as well as MBIE, Councils, NZIA, Insurance Council, SFPE, FENZ, IFE, GIB and BRANZ. This is a level of collaboration from the wider industry that hasn't occurred previously and is a sign of the central role FPANZ plays for the industry in NZ and how much of an essential aspect of building compliance the wider industry sees for Passive Fire. Joe Gilmartin from Holmes Fire will Chair this Working Group which means we are all in capable hands.

As we enter uncertain times in the construction industry, I do have a concern that all of the good that has been delivered in the Passive Fire industry over the past 4 years could be at risk of being undone by poor control of quality through cost cutting.

Tough times in construction tend to promote cost cutting, cowboys and DIY. This will hurt our industry

and all of the good that has been achieved. Therefore, it is imperative that we maintain our position and keep the focus on Quality and Compliance.



There will be a greater dependence on Fire Engineers, Third Party Inspectors and Councils to ensure the level of Quality and Compliance is maintained to the highest standard. These are the Gate keepers to ensure standards don't slip and that poor quality and non-compliance isn't allowed to prosper.

We will continue to work toward a position where Passive Fire is a recognised Specialist Trade with restricted activity. As we work toward this goal the operators that chose to invest in training, testing, quality and doing things right will be rewarded in the end and the cowboys will be found out.

Online Education and Examination Preparation

The Institution's examinations provide the opportunity for candidates to gain accredited qualifications and to satisfy the academic requirement for membership at different grades. The examinations are designed to assess underpinning knowledge and understanding at different levels, and the resulting qualifications are recognised internationally as evidence of academic achievement in fire engineering.



The New Zealand Branch of the IFE has secured a special price for those wanting to prepare for the Level 2 certificate examination, or for anyone wanting to undertake online learning of the materials covered within the Fire Science, Operations and Safety examination. In conjunction with Fire Risk Consultancy (FRC), we have teamed up to provide e-learning online.

Normal Course cost - £414 (GBP)

Aim:

The course is designed to prepare the delegate for the IFE Level 2 Certificate in Fire Science, Operations and Safety examination. This qualification has been developed by the Institution of Fire Engineers (IFE), representatives of Fire and Rescue services and other fire professionals. The content reflects best professional practice and covers key areas all firefighters should have an appreciation of.

Who is the course aimed at?

The course is aimed at those who are either preparing for employment or already employed as firefighters, who wish to develop and demonstrate knowledge and understanding relevant to the role. It is also suitable for those who work in aviation or fire safety inspection roles, who wish to demonstrate knowledge and understanding relevant to the role.

Course Content and Duration:

The course offers 60 Hours of Online learning. This special offer includes 12 months access to the FRC 'Preparing for the IFE Level 2 Certificate course'. The course covers the whole syllabus of the IFE level 2 examination and on completion provides access to a preparatory examination. The exam selects a random 100 multi choice questions from all 3 topics and these rotate after each attempt. The exam provides ideal preparation for the IFE Level 2 paper. On achieving the equivalent pass mark a certificate of achievement is provided. FRC also offer e-learning support for the other IFE examinations - www.frconline.co.uk/wp/ife-examinations/
