## WELCOME

*Welcome to July's newsletter.*

I would like to start by thanking everyone who has already updated their details and completed their membership renewal for the 2020–2021 membership year that started on 1 July. It was really pleasing to see that close to 80% have already renewed their membership and to receive such positive comments from members during this process. We are still working our way through contacting as many members as possible whilst keeping up with our current workload. Given the challenging start to the year, I am grateful for the positive feedback indicating that what we do for industry matters and enables you to get on with your daily operations knowing there is a strong advocate voice working on your behalf. If you are yet to send in your renewal declaration form, please ensure you do so asap to keep your membership current.

### NZQA Fees Free – Reminder

Last month, I spoke about the opportunities available since the government budget announcements of free training and wage subsidies for employers of

apprentices. Fire qualifications were not initially included in the training subsidy announcement, but we actively lobbied both the Tertiary Education Commission (TEC) and Competenz to have this position reviewed, and I was pleased to announce that all level 3 and 4 qualifications are now included in the fees free policy, including the latest level 3 passive installers qualification.

Our members have recognised that this means there really has never been a better time to get your staff qualified, and uptake has been significant. Please do make the most of this opportunity to get your staff working on their qualifications while the fees are being covered by the TEC.

As a reminder of what is on offer, from 1 July 2020 to 31 December 2022, all Competenz fire protection qualifications will be fees free for the first two years of level 4 apprenticeships and for all level 3 traineeships. Wage subsidies are also available through Work and Income under various schemes for employers of apprentices. These subsidies include the Apprenticeship Boost for employers of new and currently enrolled first- and second-year apprentices.

### NZS4512 Update

The updating of these standards entails a substantial process that included several opportunities for interested members to provide input into the content and development process. The first of these occurred during the Fire Alarms 'Get it Right' seminars over

the past two years. Far from simply being a training opportunity, these seminars provide a chance to discuss industry problems, solutions, and areas for improvement with your peers. Attendees at these seminars were asked for input into and feedback on changes to NZS4512, and the comments and suggestions from these previous seminars have always been very much taken into consideration as the process progresses.

The second opportunity comes in the form of a survey created by the NZS4512 committee and sent to appropriate organisations, members and companies for response. If you have ideas and feedback relevant to one of the sections being updated but haven't been invited to complete a survey about it, please do get in touch with us ASAP.

These are not insignificant opportunities, and our members were given a substantial role in shaping the direction of the industry and what is prioritised for updating or fixing. By the time the standard enters the public consultation phase, all this input has been taken into consideration and/or used to formulate significant changes. We will continue to update and remind you when the document is out for public comment. Make sure you take full advantage of the opportunities to provide input during any future focus surveys released during the development process or during the public consultation phase. It's like voting: if you don't do it, then you miss out, no longer have a voice, and have few grounds for complaints.

Finally, we expect the updated NZS4512 to be released in early 2021 and will run follow-up seminars to outline the changes made.

## **Aero Fire**

Just a reminder to check out Steve Smith's update on Aero Fire in his hand-operated fire-fighting equipment (HOFFE) special interest group (SIG) report. As you will know, Aero Fire recently received fines under the Fair Trading Act and had undertaken to no longer participate in the fire protection industry. However, the directors of this company soon popped up under another name. Keep your eyes and ears open; if you get any feedback about these individuals trying in any way, shape, or form to operate in this industry, then please let us know asap. The Commerce Commission have an ongoing file and can seek further prosecution if appropriate, and they would welcome any evidence you could provide.

Further to our HOFFE article last month, we have heard from some members that the people who operated Aero Fire, Lalita Wati Singh and Mira Singh (sole shareholder and director), have been trying to obtain fire extinguishers by various means and under various names. Should you encounter these two trying to obtain goods, please inform either the FPA

or the Commerce Commission as a condition of the Court enforceable judgement is that they do not operate in the fire protection industry. The Commerce Commission has made it quite clear that they are willing to follow up on new cases should they come to light.

The recently launched free funding initiative for level 3 & 4 NZQA qualifications has been expanded to include fire equipment qualifications thanks to some good work by the FPA. If you haven't already done so and wish to sit these qualifications, then financially speaking there is unlikely to be a better time to get the qualifications underway. It is certainly the first time I can recall where this initiative has been offered and whether it is as an industry, company or individual, having your competence, experience and skill levels recognized with qualifications can be a great advantage.

Membership enquiry and new membership requests have been consistently strong which is a sign that we are delivering what the members want.

Our ability within the SIG to collaborate positively has been a huge benefit to the group to getting information prepared and market ready. Updates for this month include:

- » Position Statements 1 – 4 – final proofs being completed and expect imminent release of these documents

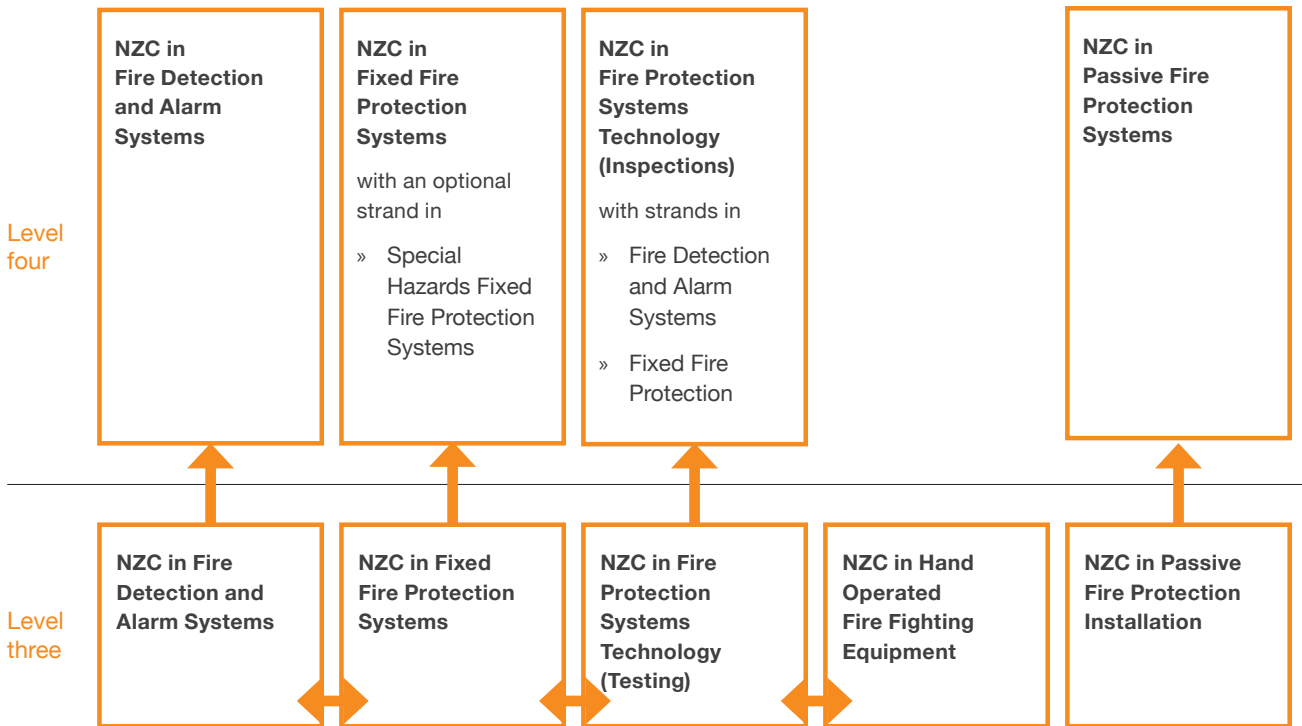

# Standard update NZS 4512 & NZS4514 Project update

<b>SUBJECT</b>	Update on the revision of NZS 4512:2010 <i>Fire detection and alarm systems in buildings</i> and NZS 4514:2009 <i>Interconnected smoke alarms for houses</i> .

## PURPOSE OF THIS UPDATE

The committee revising NZS 4512/14 has had three meetings to date. Due to the ongoing disruption of COVID-19, the third committee meeting continued to be held via online videoconferences. Committee meeting #3 was spread over 4 online Zoom meetings on 3<sup>rd</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>, 23<sup>rd</sup> of June and 1<sup>st</sup> July 2020.

This is an update of progress to date, which is intended to be circulated to the committee members, who, in turn, are encouraged to update their nominating organisation on the progress of this project.

It needs to be noted that committee deliberations are confidential. This is to ensure, among other things, that committee members are not subjected to undue pressure and that assumptions are not made by members of the public as to what may be published.

Nominating organisations are also encouraged to provide feedback to their committee member(s) on any proposed changes.

## COMPLETED & UPCOMING MILESTONES

The Covid-19 pandemic forced a switch to videoconference for meetings 2 and 3. This has delayed the overall project timeline by approximately 2 working months. Nevertheless, the committee's work is progressing well towards the revised targets.

The following milestones have been completed.

1. Initiation – finished in December 2019
2. First committee meeting – 16 & 17 December 2019, Wellington
3. Second committee meeting (truncated) – 23 March 2020
4. Supplementary half-day videoconference meetings (x7)
5. DZ 4514 draft released to SNZ editor to prepare for public comment

The upcoming milestones in the next few weeks/months are as follows.

1. 8 Standard working groups (SWG) as follows:
  - a. SWG1 – Visual Alerting Devices (VADs) – work completed
  - b. SWG2 – NZS 4514 review – final draft completed in advance of public comment
  - c. SWG3 – Wireless Detection Technology – general approach agreed, wording being drafted
  - d. SWG4 – Equipment to Overseas Standards – most work completed
  - e. SWG5 – Unprotected spaces – considering approaches with new members
  - f. SWG6 – Aspirated detection – work completed

- g. SWG7 – Security – work completed
- h. SWG8 – Documentation – work reviewed and almost completed
- 2. Future milestones are estimated as follows:
  - a. Committee meeting #4 (17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> August)
  - b. Drafting completed – end of August 2020
  - c. Commence public consultation – now estimated early October 2020
  - d. End public consultation – now estimated late November 2020
  - e. Standards published – now estimated at March 2021.

**SUMMARY OF MAJOR CHANGES PROPOSED**

The following major key changes are envisaged:

1. With regards to NZS 4512:
  - a. Changes throughout the standard to reflect changes in the New Zealand Building Code (NZBC) Compliance Documents, building legislation, and associated building documentation.
  - b. Updates to and expansion of citations of international standards, in particular ISO standards for Short-circuit isolators and Input/output devices.
  - c. Inclusion of specific provisions for the listing, design, installation, and testing of wireless-based fire detection and alarms.
  - d. Extensive additions (including an informative appendix) to fully provide for the widespread use of visual alerting devices (VADs) throughout a building.
  - e. More detailed specification and expansion of the required level of documentation, both at commissioning and throughout a system's service life.
  - f. Better definition of significant and minor deficiencies. An escalation process for partial isolations and deficiencies that are not remediated on a timely basis in also being considered.
  - g. Expanded or new provisions for: networking, environmental testing, earth fault monitoring, the normal indicator, use of standard 003 key, PSUs to be able to carry the full alarm load, connection of UL300 restaurant systems, diversity of cabling, crimp pins/ferrules, cable identification, manual call point locations, cupboards containing in situ appliances, aspirating smoke detectors, Type 5 systems, testing of line-type detectors and amplifier loading, alphanumeric display information checking, end to end testing of ancillary connections, elimination of 'red' heat detector classification, and Appendix J forms.
  - h. Input is being sought from selected nominating organisations about the possibilities of: third-party annual tests, pre-lining inspection, and an equivalent function to the Sprinkler System Certifier (SSC) for alarms.
2. With regards to NZS 4514:
  - a. Updates to cited standards and allowance for wirelessly interconnected smoke alarms with a long-life battery.

## STANDARD UPDATE NZS 4512 & NZS4514 PROJECT UPDATE *cont.*

- b. Greater clarity on where smoke alarms are required, including around exposed ceiling framing members,
- c. It is hoped that, in due course, this revised standard might be called up in whole and unmodified by the Building Code Acceptable Solutions.

The exact details of the proposed changes cannot be confirmed until the final drafts are presented to the Standards Approval Board and approved.

If your organisation has any concerns, suggestions and feedback then please provide that to your nominee to present it to the committee.
