Seminars in May and June

We are running two half-day sprinkler seismic bracing seminars on Tuesday 17 May in Auckland. These are aimed at field staff, supervisors, project managers, and anyone who works on the tools in this area. With the changes to the sprinkler standard in 2020 and the increased requirements in this area, this is a vital follow-up session covering the do's and don'ts. These sessions will also be run in Wellington on 25th May and in other locations around the rest of the country in August/ September. We will confirm these dates and locations as soon as we can.

We are also running a seminar covering the basics of passive products, the test lab process, and intumescent coatings. This is aimed at members who want a general overview of the passive sector as well as councils, engineers, and those new to the fire sector. This seminar is being held in Auckland on Tuesday 17 May and in Wellington on 1st June.

We encourage our members to send their staff to these events; they are valuable for industry networking and also provide continued professional development (CPD). As you will see below, customers who visit our website want to be able to see members who develop and keep their staff current with relevant industry training. Further details of these seminars can be found on pages 8–11.

Certified Service Providers

The association is increasingly being asked to validate or recommend members who provide services in our industry. As many of you will see, we have changed the way in which customers can search for our members on the website. Rather than a big list of members, our new search

function enables the public to find members who provide a certain type of service in an area near them. We are receiving feedback that this is easier and far more useful.

We were also being asked how to differentiate member companies according to the quality of work or qualifications and skills of their staff. The first step is the ability to search for member companies that are certified, so we have now integrated this into the search function page, enabling the public to see only companies that are certified in a certain field. As many of you will know, sprinkler, fire alarms, and evacuation have separate certification programmes that show whether a company meets minimum requirements. We are also close to launching a similar certification scheme for the passive sector.

Certified companies meet minimum requirements, such as having a certain percentage of staff who hold NZQA-recognised qualifications, having staff who undertake CPD, having quality and health and safety policies, having minimum levels of insurance, and other areas that are audited either annually or biannually. As the association grows, it is becoming more important for the public to be able to pick service providers based on more meaningful criteria than simply whether they are a financial member of the industry body. We will continue to make it easier for those needing service providers to seek out members who go the extra distance to become certified in their respective fields.

We have also updated the page that outlines the membership levels and explains what they mean; this can be found here: https://www.fpanz.org/membership/about-membership. This page also explains the types of certifications for our industry in more detail.

FPANZ Strategy and Direction

The board and management are meeting mid May for a strategy and planning session. Our association has a constitution that largely dictates our purpose and activities, and we need to regularly assess whether we are meeting those objectives and what we can do to continue to grow and provide more to our members and the wider public. The association has grown considerably in the past 4–5 years and is now in a very good position: our reputation and brand is well recognised, we are consulted in key areas, our members get far greater visibility than non-members, and we are in a solid financial position to leverage our future growth. With all of this in mind, and considering the feedback I regularly receive from members when I get to speak with them, this strategy session will be looking at areas to focus on in the next few financial years. I look forward to reporting back once this has taken place and relaying some of the plans we will be working on.

FireNZ Conference 2022

HOFFE SIG Update

We are slowly getting more of our freedoms back, ironically this is as news breaks of yet another COVID variant arriving on the international stage and in New Zealand. We are certainly in unsettling times both here and overseas. As we can see from both the pricing and the problems with the availability of some products, these situations impact us all personally and professionally, that said it is also hard for businesses when they are trying to plan ahead in this environment.

An FPA member company brought a situation to our attention which, while not a new concern it does make you wonder about how some of our authorities see their role in policing/enforcing the established standards and regulations which we in the fire equipment industry are told we must abide by.

When we are bringing HOFFE into the country we are told to bring in equipment compliant with the regulations and to abide by the published protocols when doing so. In the case of our fire extinguishers, as they are Class 2.2 Dangerous Goods, they are subject to a test/clearance certificate as required by the Hazardous Substances (Compressed Gases) Regulations 2004 clause 19 where it states "A person who imports a cylinder or a batch of cylinders into New Zealand must apply for and obtain a test certificate from a test certifier." While with mandatory words like "must" being used it seems fairly straight forward, there is mounting evidence that while some are following the advice/requirements contained in the regulation, some are not following these protocols and obtaining these certificates. The effect of this is that it creates a potential price point advantage in the marketplace for those who are not complying with this requirement.

The next part to this puzzle is that if you have a regulatory requirement with penaltyies attached, then is there not an expectation that if the requirements aren't followed then there would be a penalty applied to those aren't abiding by the requirements of the regulation? Given that companies which are abiding by the regulations and obtaining the required certificates are incurring considerable expense in doing so, not enforcing the regulations means there can be considerable reward for non-compliance!

Some of these products are openly offered for sale at prices that, on the face of it, would seem fairly tempting. Unfortunately, it has the potential to trap companies and people who are trying to do the right thing in order to comply with other regulatory requirements such as DG, marine, Fire Safety and Evacuation etc. They will purchase these FE products from companies not realizing they haven't put their products through the same required checks and processes as other equivalent FE products have. Some food for thought?

Our next HOFFE group meeting is on Friday the 20th May at the Royal NZ Yacht Squadron, however you can still log on via Zoom.

Evacuation Consultants SIG Update

As you are most likely aware, the country is now operating at the Covid Protection Framework, orange setting. This means that we can now resume fire drills throughout the country. If, following a suitable assessment that you deem there are genuine covid-19 risks associated with running a fire drill you should speak with FENZ, or your evacuation consultant for advice.

Recently there has been some further discussion about unwanted alarm activations. The debriefing phase of a fire drill, or part of a training session can be used to help occupants understand how their alarm hardware functions. It provides a good environment to offer suggestions about reducing unwanted alarms and FENZ call outs. This would include training on the proper use of systems that can be reset by occupants.

Don't forget that if you are responsible for planning fire drill, and evacuation exercises you are able to access our good practice guide to running drills $\underline{\text{here}}$.

I wanted to let you know that consultation is opening on Monday 2 May 2022 for the 2022 Building Code update process. The consultation will run until Friday 1 July 2022.

MBIE updates selected Building Code acceptable solutions and verification methods annually to ensure it is keeping pace with new methods of construction, products and technologies.

This year's proposed changes aim to make new buildings better protect the safety and wellbeing of New Zealanders, and focus on plumbing and drainage, protection from fire and structural stability of hollow-core floors.

Plumbing and drainage

We are proposing changes to improve the safety and reliability of plumbing and drainage systems.

Hollow-core floors

We are proposing changes to the compliance pathway for the use of hollow-core floor systems in new buildings

Protection from fire for residential homes

SPRINKLER SEISMIC SYSTEMS Get it Right Seminar



We resume our Get it right Sprinkler Seminar series that were cut short by lockdown restrictions. This new series is driven by the ongoing changes we face as an industry and the importance of selecting the right products to meet the seismic design and installation requirements of NZS4541:202.

FPANZ is running a series of half day workshops throughout the country – our aim is to ensure that the industry is continuing to get the latest information and support. These half day workshops will focus on the seismic bracing of sprinkler systems, their components and associated approved hardware. We will be you showing examples that do not meet the requirements of NZS4541:2020. There will be an emphasis on the need to plan and install seismic bracing that meets the requirements of these standards.

The workshops will not work through how to calculate loads and select components – it is more on the emphasis on why and when to do so. A follow-up seminar will refresh how to calculate in the near future.

NZS4541:2020 was published in March 2020 and places much greater emphasis on new seismic resilience requirements of the standard.

The changes to the seismic provisions are ground-breaking, and require a new approach to how the designs are carried out, documented, and installed. These half day will be interactive and there will be lots of ability to ask questions and to participate in discussing solutions and problems in the seismic areas of sprinkler systems under the new standard. We strongly encourage the attendance of site supervisory staff who will benefit from this seminar.

EARTHQUAKES

Following recent earthquakes events in NZ (Christchurch and Kaikoura) the building industry is facing increasing pressure to design to protect the building and occupants against earthquake damage.

Generally, sprinkler systems have performed admirably in these events, however there has been some criticism of how we are designing our seismic bracing systems. The playing field has changed, and the construction sector is expecting more from the fire industry.

The presenters will outline what will now be expected to ensure that systems can be certified as compliant with the new provisions of the standards.
