## HOFFE SIG Update

Well what an interesting month it has been the All Blacks are coming home with a real mixed bag of results, probably best summed up by the way the England game (which they looked to be easily winning despite the penalties) ended up in a draw!

I figured that as there have been many claims made in recent time about Lithium-Ion fire extinguishers I should put some information out there about the current industry position:

- a) Technology is moving faster than the solutions to the issues e.g. demand is for longer duration batteries to provide longer ranges for planes, vessels, vehicles, bicycles and faster recharging times. However, when this increases the consequence of battery failure (Thermal runaway etc) and risk to people and property increases - does it make sense?
- b) While the FP-003 committee have many capable members, and have visibility of the problem, do not expect any solution any time soon to what is an international problem.
- c) A Technical Advisory Note (09) was issued by FPA Australia earlier this year - in the Summary section it states “As both AS/NZS1841 and 1850 are legislated under the Mandatory Standard, this means that portable fire extinguishers currently available for sale and use in Australia for Lithium battery risks cannot be sold or installed with the Australian Standards Certification mark.” They go on to say that the FPA and Technical Advisory Committee “are reviewing various global standards for testing procedures for portable fire extinguishers for use on Lithium battery fires. Due to the manufacture changes in these batteries, fire testing is extremely difficult.”
- d) While ISO and other options are being discussed the fact is that there are “No fire extinguishers approved under the AS/NZS framework as being suitable for Lithium-Ion fires as there is no standards test for this class of fire available under this framework”.
- e) Clearly this is an evolving issue internationally and one to which we are all potentially exposed as we use various devices, vehicles and tools which utilize this technology. However while some well qualified people pragmatically review extinguishing agent and testing options, we as fire protection companies can only wait while those developing the AS/NZS framework continue searching for a searching for a way to expedite a solution to this ever evolving risk.

### On a different note...

Another matter from the media that is worth noting is that Marsden Point Refinery – now known as “Channel Infrastructure” pleaded guilty to 14 charges of discharging up to 60,000lt of foam made with PFAS chemicals during firefighting training seven times during May and June last year. A whistle-blower within the company alerted the EPA who brought the charges against the company resulting in a fine of \$169K.

The upgrade was due to take place during November, however, recent developments have provided an opportunity to enhance the platform. The release has been delayed until the new year. At the last SIG Meeting we were fortunate to be shown the beta version, and it is looking good – we eagerly await the new system.

We are currently working through the criteria required for maintaining the Certified Evacuation Consultant qualification, we expect to release further information around this in the new year. You are all welcome to actively participate in the SIG meetings. We continue to work with each other, and fire and emergency NZ to ensure we continue to evolve evacuation practices to help keep building occupants safe.

# Passive Fire Protection SIG Update

## Passive Fire – Can't see the forest for the Trees:

The Fire Safety industry in NZ has reacted to what was a big problem. Fire Stopping was not being done well, or at all. Through great contributors & FPANZ Passive SIG Fire stopping is now well and truly on the radar of every participant on every project in NZ.

We now have genuine Specialist Contractors, Dedicated designers, Third Party, Multiple test labs & 1000's more available tested solutions than we once did.

However, we've gone so far down the rabbit hole of interrogation of Fire stopping that we've lost focus of the big picture. In fact we've made an art & entire industry of interrogating the minor details & installations and completely forgotten to take a good look at the remainder of the Fire Separation.

On a typical fire separation, the fire stopping might make up 1% of the Fire spread risk, yet it is receiving 100% of the attention.

I for one would like to put some time & energy in 2023 into working with the wider industry on education regarding all things Passive Fire & ensuring those charged with inspection are actually looking at all elements of Passive Fire. This includes:

- » Fire wall & ceiling construction (Plasterboard, concrete & other systems)
- » Dampers
- » Fire doors
- » Façades
- » Slab edge
- » Wall terminations & junctions
- » Roof terminations
- » Etc

Architects, Engineers, IQP's, Contractors, Builders, Third Party & other specialist trades will benefit by education on all aspects of Passive Fire Protection.

The current approach of "tagging" yourself of liability is not a mature industry approach. If everyone points to the next person in the circle then the finger just keeps getting pointed around & around. We need to educate better & look at the bigger picture.

Councils & Fire Engineers are the ultimate gate keepers of this quality pass/ fail & hopefully are up for the challenge to start looking at the forest.
