## Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs)

At FPA NZ, our national council and governance board recognise the importance of collaborating more closely with other likeminded global organisations as part of our strategic objectives. A common question is why this and other MoU's are necessary, New Zealand is different, has its own codes, standards etc. As we know, New Zealand, and indeed Australia and Fiji, represent relatively small markets on the global stage. This has significant implications for manufacturers, suppliers, and the overall training of our industry workforce.

While there are certainly challenges and differences in codes and standards globally, we will aim to leverage the excellent work already accomplished by these organisations, adapting it with a 'localised' approach to keep training and content development costs as low as possible. Our association encompasses a diverse range of specialty sectors for example, Passive Fire, Sprinklers, Fire Alarms, Handheld Firefighting, Evacuation, Inspection, Product Supply and Engineering. Operating in isolation is both expensive and totally unsustainable for a market our size and will fail to serve our entire FPA NZ membership effectively. To address this, we have established several key arrangements to share work and collaborate on topics that will benefit all parties involved. ►

With our last public holiday of the year, Labour weekend now behind us we are starting that countdown to Christmas, funny how it seems to come around quicker each year?

Also behind us now is the FireNZ Conference and Exhibition which from the feedback seems to have been a great success and well attended.

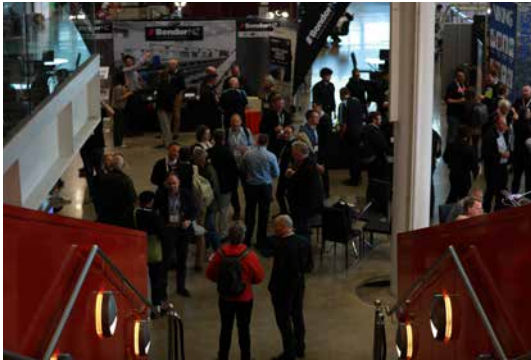
We are continuing to hear stories about magic sticks and other fire extinguishers implying, and in some cases stating, that their equipment complies with standards that they cannot comply with. While the obvious examples are the fire extinguishers targeting Lithium-Ion and claiming to be AS/NZS certified for these fires, another example of this include the “magic sticks” claiming a 2B rating that is specifically reserved for CO2 fire extinguishers and a 1C under AS/NZS 1850 when a 1C doesn’t exist under the AS/NZS1850 ratings scheme. There are many other examples of where these unsubstantiated claims are made by various companies, this is both disappointing and screams buyer beware.

It has always been part of our role to behave ethically and where possible to help educate our clients as to why they should purchase from a FPANZ member company. When, as a member company, we sign up to the code of ethics it means something, we would also hope that it helps to reassure the client that they are dealing with a responsible company that operates to a higher standard than the companies making unsubstantiated claims and misrepresenting products in order to get a sale.

Our next HOFFE Group meeting is at 1pm on the 26th of November, a day before our FPANZ AGM on the 27th November.

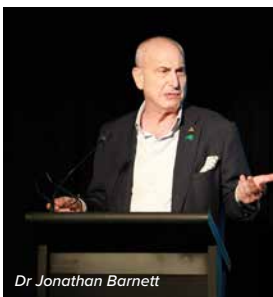

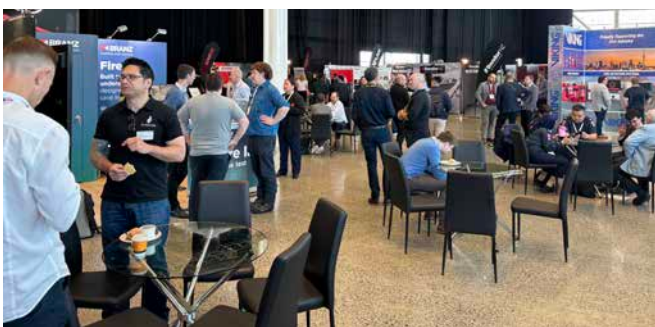
